## Aims

The aims of the educational project "All Together for a Global Celebration" focus both on informing our students about the significance of these special days and on developing skills and values related to these celebrations. Our aims for this project will be for the students: • to understand the social, environmental, cultural and economic issues raised through such World Days eg International Day of Acceptance (20 January 2025), Random Acts of Kindness Day (17 February 2025), International Day of Forests (21 March 2025); • to develop empathy for the people or issues honoured or supported by World Days (e.g. people with disabilities); • to promote solidarity, respect for diversity and equality, understanding the importance of justice and cooperation; • to develop the ability to solve and discuss the different perspectives and approaches related to World Days; • to express themselves creatively through posters, presentations, plays, videos etc. that project the messages of the World Days.

## **Expected Results**

Upon completion of the project, students will acquire both basic knowledge and skills that will help them become responsible and aware citizens, with an active role in issues affecting their society and their planet. Students will strengthen their empathy by learning to understand and respect the feelings and needs of other people and even those of animals. Through group activities, students will practise cooperation and teamwork and will value the ideas and opinions of others. They will cultivate communication and collaboration skills through role-playing and group artwork. Through the activities, students will nourish values such as respect, solidarity, friendship and responsibility which will help them develop a positive attitude towards others and the world.
