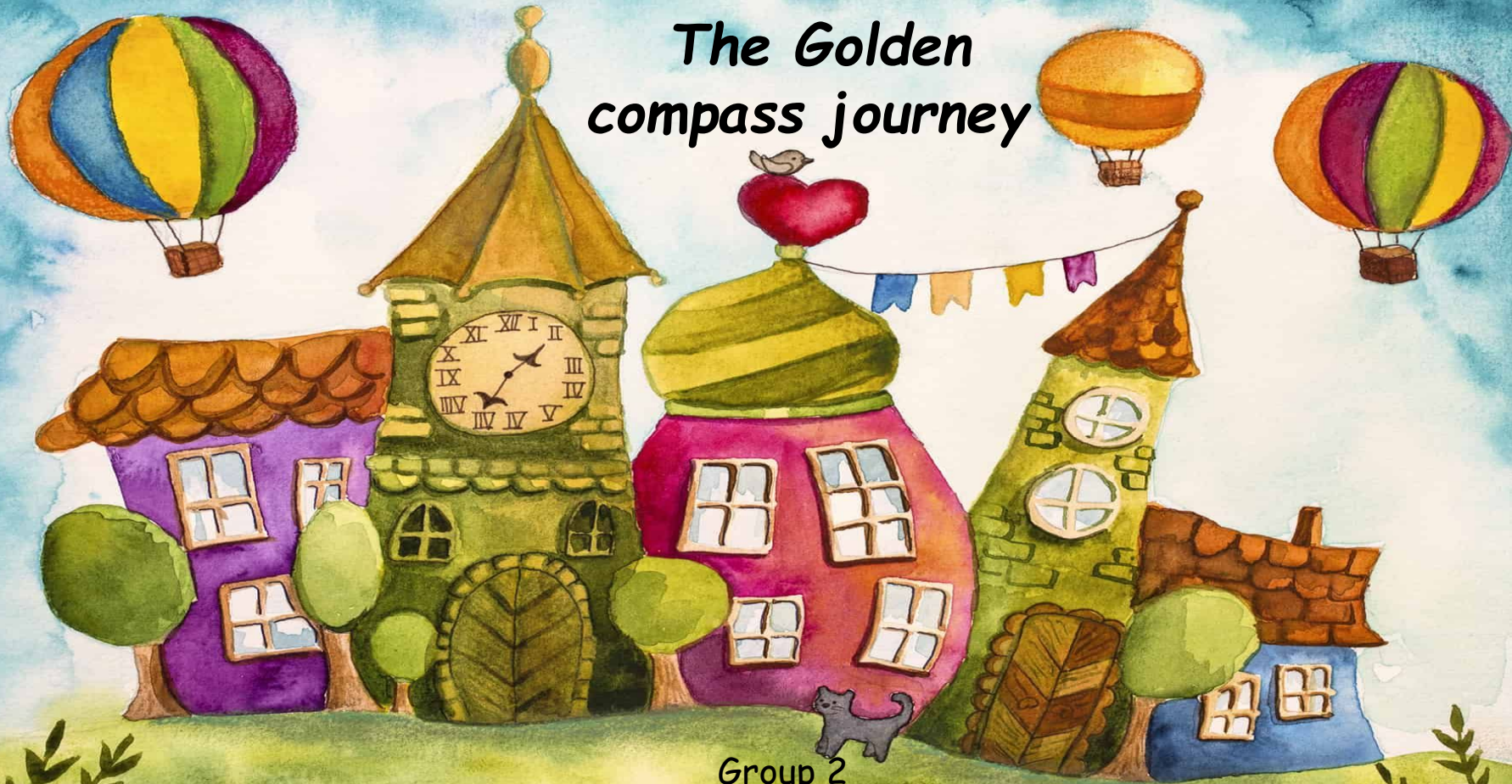

As soon as she picked it up, it started turning like crazy only to stop and point towards the forbidden forest.

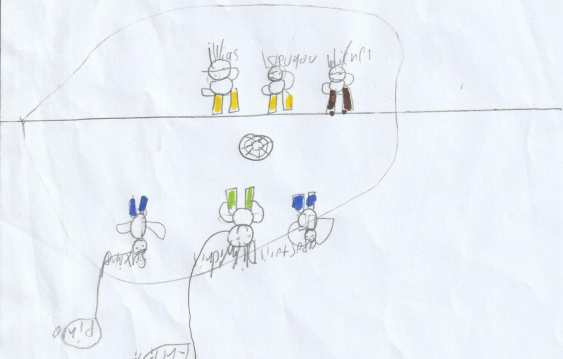
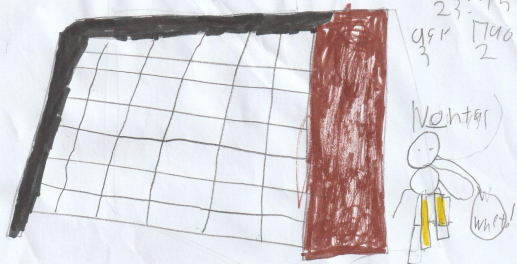
They immediately followed its directions and were found in the middle of the forest where there was a small house. Inside a little girl was dancing and singing. They asked her why she was there

and she replied that she had lost her compass and couldn't find her way back home.

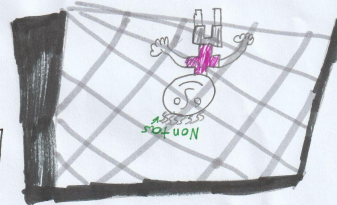
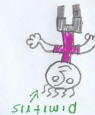
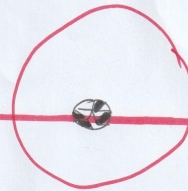
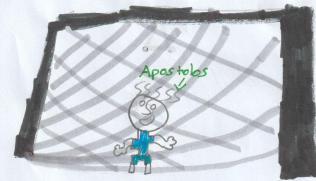
The children then showed her and they all realised that the compass they had found was the one the little girl had lost.
