Students from Greece prepared a digital crossword about Women's rights using

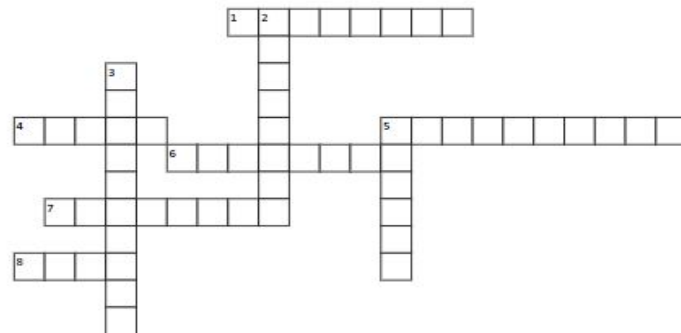

1. a range of social movements, political movements, and ideologies that aim to define and establish the political, economic, personal, and social equality of the sexes
