INSTRUCTIONS AND GUIDELINE FOR EACH PARTNER COUNTRY:

FIRST DAY - 13TH DECEMBER / MONDAY:

- 1) Each partner school students will present their school, city and country through a video or presentation.
- 2) The students will play a Kahoot game about this activity. So, each partner school teachers will send 3 questions to Turkey for the Kahoot challenge game about their school-city-country introduction through email or Whatsapp. The students should not know the questions in advance.
- 3) Each partner school (teachers or students) will *briefly* introduce *a few* school projects to achieve the aim: "sharing good practices"

SECOND DAY - 14TH DECEMBER / TUESDAY:

Science Workshop:

- Each partner country students will prepare compost in the same time. So, the students will bring soil, small bins, kitchen and garden waste from their house to the school for the activity *or* the schools can provide the waste in advance. The Science teachers should guide students for this activity.
- Students will write slogans about saving environment. We have 2 options regarding your school conditions:

 1-Teachers will supply colourful or white cardboards and pens/crayons/markers to write slogans for making a poster about saving environment
- 2-Students will use online web tools (e.g.Canva) to make posters

Play to the beat activity:

- Each partner school students will shortly perform one of their traditional dances (e.g. video or live performance) with the guidance of their teachers.
- Each partner school students will shortly perform a rhythm dance with the guidance of their teachers (e.g. video or live performance).
- Students will bring hard plastic cups (non-disposable) to the classroom/lab to play the Cup Game rhythm activity.

THIRD DAY - 15TH DECEMBER / WEDNESDAY:

Maths Activity (Reveal the Hidden Slogan):

- We will play a PowerPoint game to reveal a slogan related to our project. To carry out the activities more easily, the students should be trained for the subject: Equivalent fractions in Maths. If the students already know it, the subject may be revised then. So, the students will come ready for the activity.

Cooking Time Activity:

- Each partner country students will shortly perform and introduce one of their traditional dishes through pre-recorded videos or presentations with visuals
- We will make a Junior Masterchef contest in their schools. This activity will be *pre-recorded* as a video before the mobility. Each school will create groups of students. The groups will make fruit yoghurt in 5 minutes in a classroom/garden. After 5 minutes, the jury of teachers will evaluate the fruit yoghurt of each

group and choose the winner. The winner will be announced and awarded with a nice certificate in the Zoom meeting. The students will wait for the meeting day to learn the results.

- Each school has to decide and provide the ingredients. The basic ingredients are yoghurt, fruit, honey, sugar, bowl or cup, spoons but each school can enrich the list as they wish. The hygiene precautions will be provided by each school. The main criteria to choose the winner will be the taste, decoration and timing.

Traditional Games Activity:

- Each partner country students will perform and introduce one of their traditional children or street games through videos, presentations with pictures or with a live performance.

FOURTH DAY – 16TH DECEMBER / THURSDAY:

Migration and Education Workshop:

- We will make posters in this activity. So we have two options again regarding your school conditions:
- 1-Teachers will supply colourful or white cardboards and pens/crayons/markers to write slogans for students to make a poster
- 2-Students will use online web tools (e.g.Canva) to make posters

FIFTH DAY – 17TH DECEMBER / FRIDAY:

Outdoor Education activity:

The outdoor activity will be done before the mobility week and pre-recorded to be watched on 17th December in Zoom screen. The theme of the activity is Autumn. Each school will visit a park or any other natural place. The students will wander the place and do an activity of art (e.g. drawings, taking photographs, creating pictures with leaves, recycling act). So, each country should prepare the planning for visiting a natural place where students can view signs of autumn. As the host country, we will use the pictures/photos by the students to create an online exhibition after the meeting, as well.

Traditional Art Activity:

- Turkey will introduce the Water Marbling and then each partner school will introduce one of their traditional arts briefly with presentations or live.

NOTE:

- Each school should provide online access tools and gadgets for students to play Kahoot, use Canva and evaluation surveys.
- Each video or presentation should not be longer than 15 minutes.
- Also, headphones should be provided for the students for the breakout room activities in Zoom (Monday and Thursday).

- The Zoom meeting link and passcode will be shared on 9th December through Project Gmail group account and Whatsapp group.
