Brief descripti on	The project will be based on sharing the customs and traditions of each country in an organized way around a monthly theme: Traditions, gastronomy, ways of life, important dates, history, traditional music and dances, etc. carried out in schools. These shares will be made through digital platforms or to anyone who wishes, by sending Christmas cards or postcards/drawings from your locality, for example.		
Objectives	This eTwinning project aims to promote cultural exchange between children from different countries, through sharing traditions, customs and celebrations typical of their cultures. Throughout the project, students will explore and present their local traditions, whilst discovering those of other partner countries. The main skills developed include: -Intercultural skills, through the appreciation of cultural diversity; -Linguistic skills, when communicating with children of other languages; -Digital skills, when using online collaborative tools; -Social and civic skills, promoting respect and empathy. In this way, the project encourages international cooperation and the personal and social development of the children involved.		
Development	The eTwinning project will have as one of its main pillars the creation of a collaborative digital wall (Padlet), where the schools involved will be able to share and discover the richness of traditions, festive dates, celebrations and other cultural aspects of different countries. Throughout the year, students will have the opportunity to explore varied themes, such as typical cuisine, history and local products, allowing an exchange of knowledge and experiences that highlight cultural diversity. Each participating school will contribute texts, videos, photos or other resources about their festivities and traditions, such as Christmas celebrations, local festivals, seasonal customs or typical dishes, creating an interactive space where everyone can learn about and value cultural differences. In addition to the		

conclusion	digital wall, the sending of postcards between schools will be promoted, creating a closer and more personal connection between students, encouraging the exchange of handwritten messages and the development of new international friendships. This project not only encourages cultural sharing, but also develops important skills such as cooperation, intercultural communication and the use of technologies, promoting mutual respect and curiosity for traditions from other countries. The final product will result from all the shares that can be seen on the wall (padlet) or other digital tools as well as the physical products that are created and which can be recorded in videos, photos or texts. In each school/classroom an exhibition and also shared using digital platforms.
