The caryatid porch of the Temple of Athena at Eretria, Greece, was a sacred space where the goddess Athena was worshipped. The statues, known as caryatids, were believed to be the women who supported the temple's roof during its construction. The temple was destroyed by the Persians in 480 BC, and the caryatids were brought to Rome, where they were used as a metaphor for strength and endurance.
