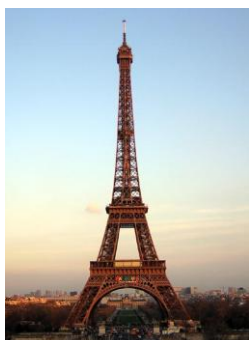


## My favourite capital
