










Primary Education

Dimotiko (elementary school):



Attendance at Dimotiko lasts 6 years.


The basic goal of the Dimotiko is to ensure the children's all-round, harmonious and balanced mental and physical development.







Dimotiko (elementary school):





A school year consists of 3 semesters and the pupils' evaluation is:


- 1st 2nd grade: descriptive evaluation
- 3rd 4th grade: A (excellent), B (very good), Γ (good) and E (fail)
- 5th 6th grade: numbers from 1 to 10.

All- day primary schools are in operation, with an extended timetable and an enriched Curriculum.














Gymnasio (junior high school):






Attendance at Gymnasio lasts **3** years.

Lower secondary (Gymnasio) schooling is based on a wide curriculum which aims to provide subject specific knowledge and to prepare pupils for their role as citizens in society.





Gymnasio (junior high school):





The grading system runs on a scale of 20 (highest) to 1 (10 being a pass). Evaluation is based on:

- day to day oral tests
- the general involvement in the learning process
- short written tests
- written tests without warning
- written final examinations or projects





Classes last 35 to 45 min and there are breaks of 10 and 5 minutes between them.


















Post-compulsory (upper) Secondary Education

It includes two types of school:



Students who want to continue their studies at a university usually enrol in

Geniko Lykeio (High school)

• Age: 15-18

• Duration: 3 years



The students must take the Panhellenic National Examinations to proceed to the Higher Tertiary education.



These exams are held after the students have received their Apolytirion (the main school-leaving certificate for secondary education)

The curriculum includes:

- technological lessons (theoretical and laboratory) in specific fields.






