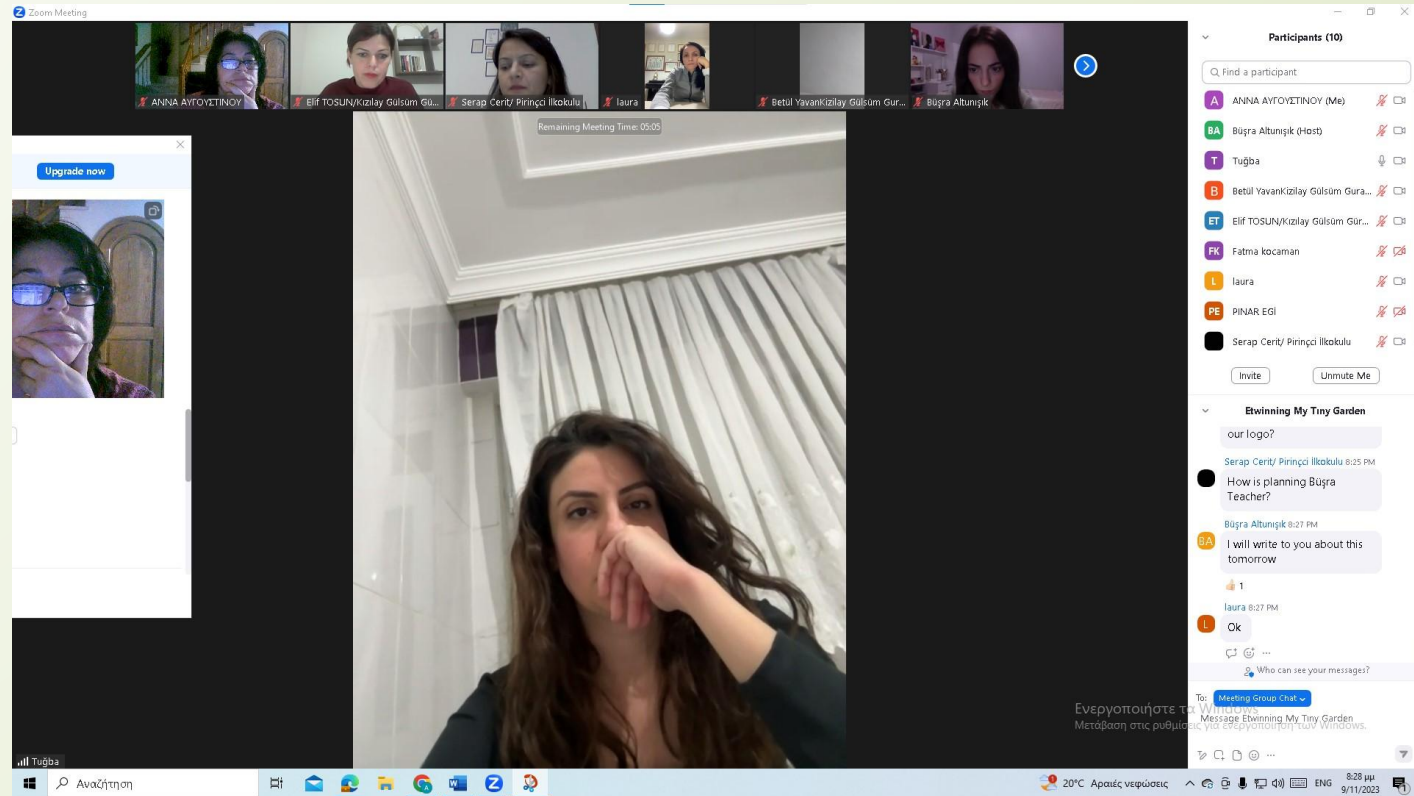




My tiny garden

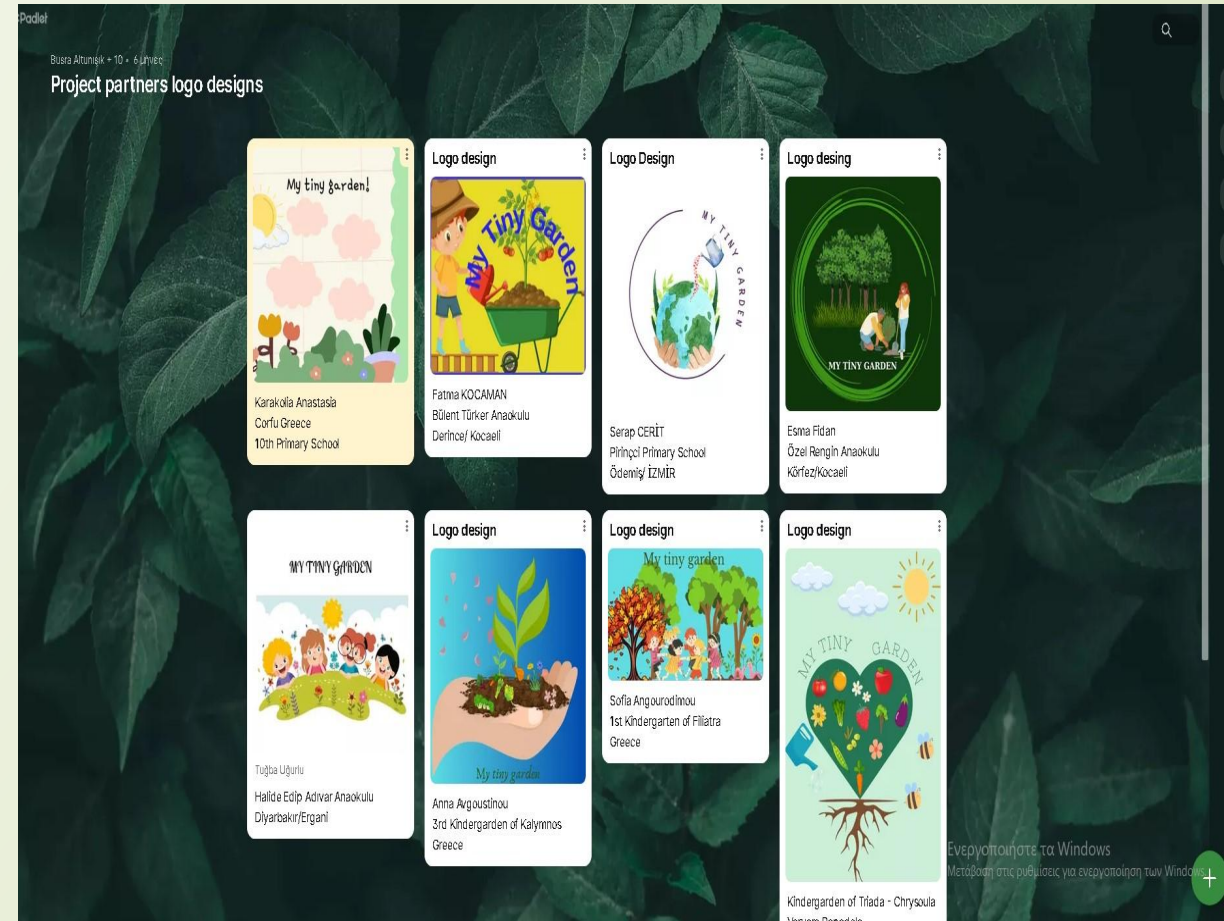

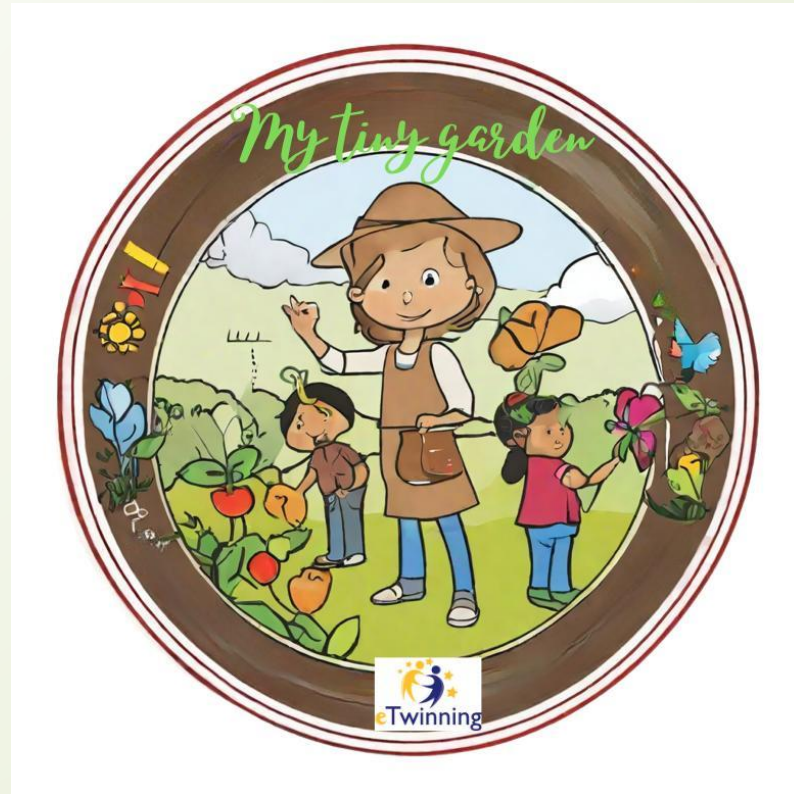

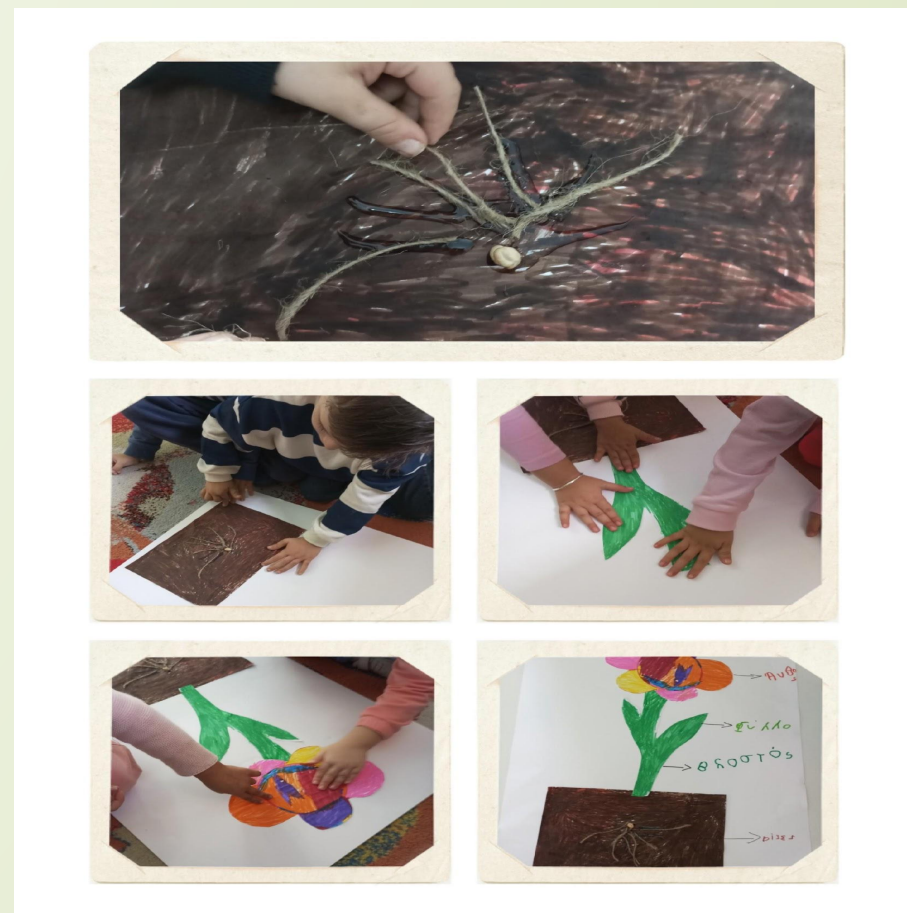
