the amphora!**



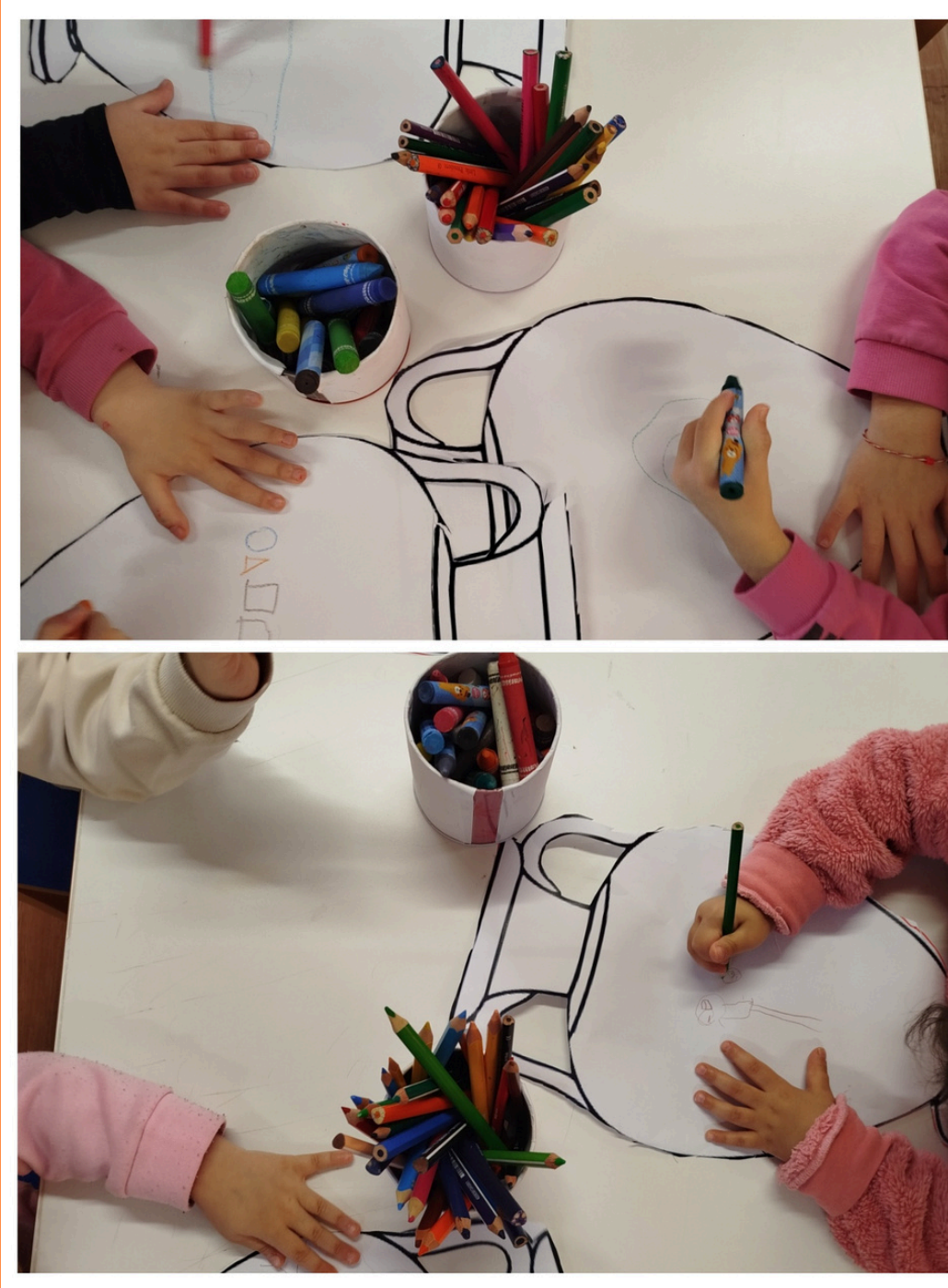
One of the exhibits in the museum we visited that impressed our students was the amphora. We observed various amphorae and talked about their usefulness. Amphorae in ancient Greece were used to store wine or oil. The amphorae were decorated with themes drawn from the daily life of the ancient Greeks.



In our class we observed amphorae and put together the "amphora puzzle"!



Our students created their own amphorae with joy and imagination.



We also tried the papier mache technique. When our amphora dried, we painted it and designed the Argo. According to Greek mythology, the Argo was the ship on which the Argonauts boarded in order to go to Colchis and get the Golden Fleece.
