


### 4th Kindergarten School of Megara

### The ancient plaggona doll was the exhibit that attracted the children's interest.






#### Then we created our own plaggona doll!








## We had fun giving our doll forms of movement!

# We returned to our classroom and the children drew what impressed them from the museum.










In the sequel, the children, with imagination and creativity, made their own doll. They cut off the body parts and joined them together with double nails.
