


# 4th Kindergarten School of Megara

an ancient greek doll!*




**We visited the archaeological museum of Megara. Our goal was for the children to come into contact with and learn about the cultural elements of their place.**






**The ancient plaggona doll was the exhibit that attracted the children's interest.**

doll forms of movement!**








**And then we

bodies.**





We returned to our classroom and the children drew what impressed them from the museum.
