## Defeating Coronacula

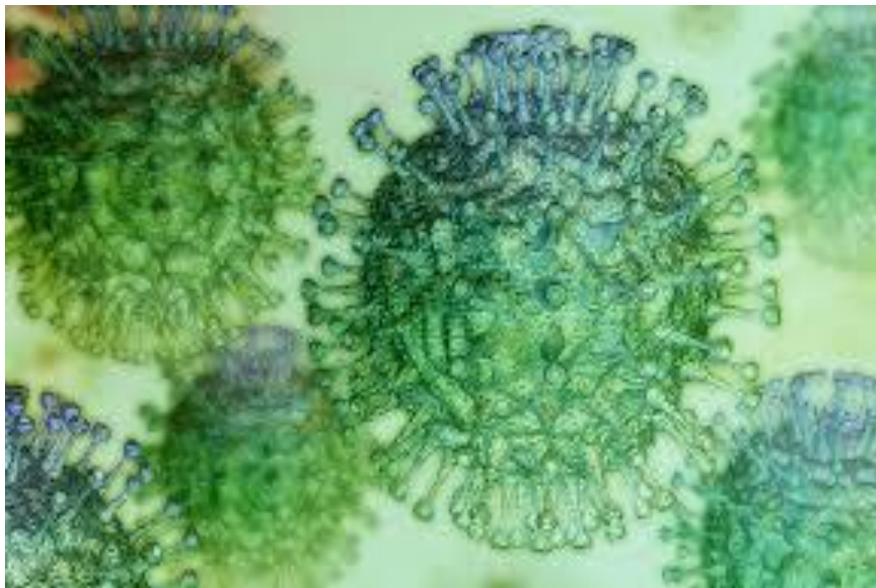
Once upon a time, two sisters, Rebecca and Freya lived happily on a beautiful planet with the company of the animals, which were their only family, since they had lost their parents.
