Αττικής για την ΣΤ΄ τάξη των Δημοτικών σχολείων της Διεύθυνσης Πρωτοβάθμιας Εκπαίδευσης Δ΄ Αθήνας και όλες τις τάξεις των Γυμνασίων της Διεύθυνσης Δευτεροβάθμιας Εκπαίδευσης Δ΄ Αθήνας, ευχαριστεί και συγχαίρει όλους τους μαθητές και τις μαθήτριες για την πολυπληθή συμμετοχή τους και τις πραγματικά αξιόλογες εργασίες τους. #### **Defeating Coronacula**


Once upon a time, two sisters, Rebecca and Freya lived happily on a beautiful planet with the company of the animals, which were their only family, since they had lost their parents.
