Hi! This month I am going to meet the Cycladic figurines in ancient Greece! They will teach me the feeling of calm!









Cyclades: The origins of Cycladic figurines

Which of the three music instruments is an harp?
















Here is another type of cycladic figurine.. It is called violin-shaped figurine.






In ancient times, people living in Cyclades, made animal like artifacts..

How many pigeons do you see in the picture? Circle the correct number!






There many other artifacts that served for their needs in every day life like pan-shaped figurines and pots..

Can you find them?












Imagine that you live in this house by the sea... How do you feel? Draw your expression..








This is another painting of Michalis Oikonomou... Imagine you are looking at theese rough sea waves! How do you feel? Draw your expression!















Here is an idea of drawing a face of a cycladic figurine.

This is Winter in a cycladic figurine!
































