

# Συμβουλές για τη Σωστή Χρήση του Διαδικτύου

## PERSONAL DATA

Personal data is any information that refers to a person and describes it, such as name, age, residence, occupation, marital status, education, financial status, and personal data used on a daily basis as it browses the Internet. Anonymity on the Internet and the possibility of creating fake profiles, leads to not really knowing who we are communicating with. Men use profiles with female characteristics and vice versa, trying to extract a child's personal information and seduce him. Such as:

Encourage the child not to use easy passwords on the websites he / she registers, dates of birth.

Read the terms of use of the websites your child visits and registers (social networking sites, forums and blogs). Then encourage your child to do the same.

Advise your child not to post photos or videos that he or she would not show to people in the "real world" or that could put him or her in a difficult position when he or she grows up. in any case their permission.

If the child has his own blog, make sure that its content is not abusive or racist.

Do not forget that you parents must first follow the rules of safe navigation to set an example to your children ... think about how your child will feel if while you urge him to protect his personal photos you upload them to Facebook? Teach your child how to behave in real life, so he should behave the same on the Internet.
