Selimiye Mosque, Ottoman Sultan II. It is a social complex built by Mimar Sinan during the reign of Selim I and located in Edirne, the previous capital of the Ottoman Empire. Selimiye Mosque, built by Mimar Sinan at the age of 80 and described as "my masterwork", is considered to be one of the most important works of both Mimar Sinan and Ottoman architecture. The most

rebuilt in 1867 by
Pertevniyal Sultan, the
mother of Sultan Abdulaziz.
The mosque, which is one
of the last period Ottoman
works, bears the traces of
European baroque
architecture. The mosque

double minarets has a
narthex with three small


