## During the week from 7-11<sup>th</sup> of March

- We hosted the writer and poet Mika Mavrogianni .
- The author talked to students of C class, about the woman as the main character in literature.
- It was a tribute to the Woman's Day of March 8th.
- The children got to know the poetic and prose work of the author, who kindly offered a lot of copies of her poetry collections:
- WOMEN'S MONOLOGUE"
   and
- MENS 'MONOLOGUE.





• We dealt with the women's issue, we discussed and reflected on gender equality, the emancipation of women as they entered the labor market from the Industrial Revolution onwards, the discrimination against them, the racism, the sexism that was accepted through the centuries until the emergence of the feminist movement in the late 19th century and at the beginning of the 20th c

- That movement contributed to the advancement of women's position
- Children understood why women fought for a better life, better working conditions, the recognition of their basic individual rights, their education, profession, right to vote, protection of motherhood and personal respect.



- Another day the same week we welcomed the author Olga Vlachou,
- she talked to B class
- about the role of Love in Literature and in her writing work as a source of inspiration.



- She shared her experience of creative writing and offered to students a copy of her work
- "THE HEART OF THE GOD".

  We warmly thanked both authors for their efficient cooperation with the students of our school and their kind contribution.
- They really made a great presentation on the week celebration of Woman's Day





- Another Day we hosted Mrs. Filia Mitromara to talk to A Class.
- She is a journalist, writer and wellness editor who captivated her audience by talking about her own personal experiences as a child and teenager, having suffered both bullying and discrimination.
- With extreme directness she captured the feelings of a child when she accepts such behaviors.
- She explained how she managed to turn all the negativeness that happened to her into positiveness, to believe in herself and her potential, to fight and manage to do in her life what she dreamed of.




- She answered many students' questions with warmth and honesty.

She mentioned strongly to be understood from everyone that:

- the basis for reducing incidents of bullying and for children to gain respect for diversity is knowledge and the immediate search for help.
- Vulnerability, sensitivity, diversity is not a shame, asking for help is not a shame.
- Acceptance the diversity is very important and shows respect.
   And this must be heard loudly and clearly at any time.








- Another task was students to write stories about Equality.

θέματα οιμονομιμά, θρησιμεντιμά, μαθώς μαι θέματα χονιμότητας.

Η συνηθέστερη μορφή ενδοοιμοχενειαμής βίας είναι η σεξουαλιμή η οποία περιλαμβάνει βίαιες μαι μαμοποιητιμές συμπεριφορές, όπως π.χ. χειροδιμία, συμυχιμό βιασμό, ημιά σε μωτιμά όρχανα μλπ. Σε μάποιες περιπτώσεις προμαλείται σωματιμή παραμόρφωση ή αμόμα μαι θάνατος. Οι ενδοοιμοχενειαμοί φόνοι μπορεί να χίναν για ηρτήματα τιμής, για την προίμα μαι για άλλους παράχοντες.
