- We did it through these 2 years

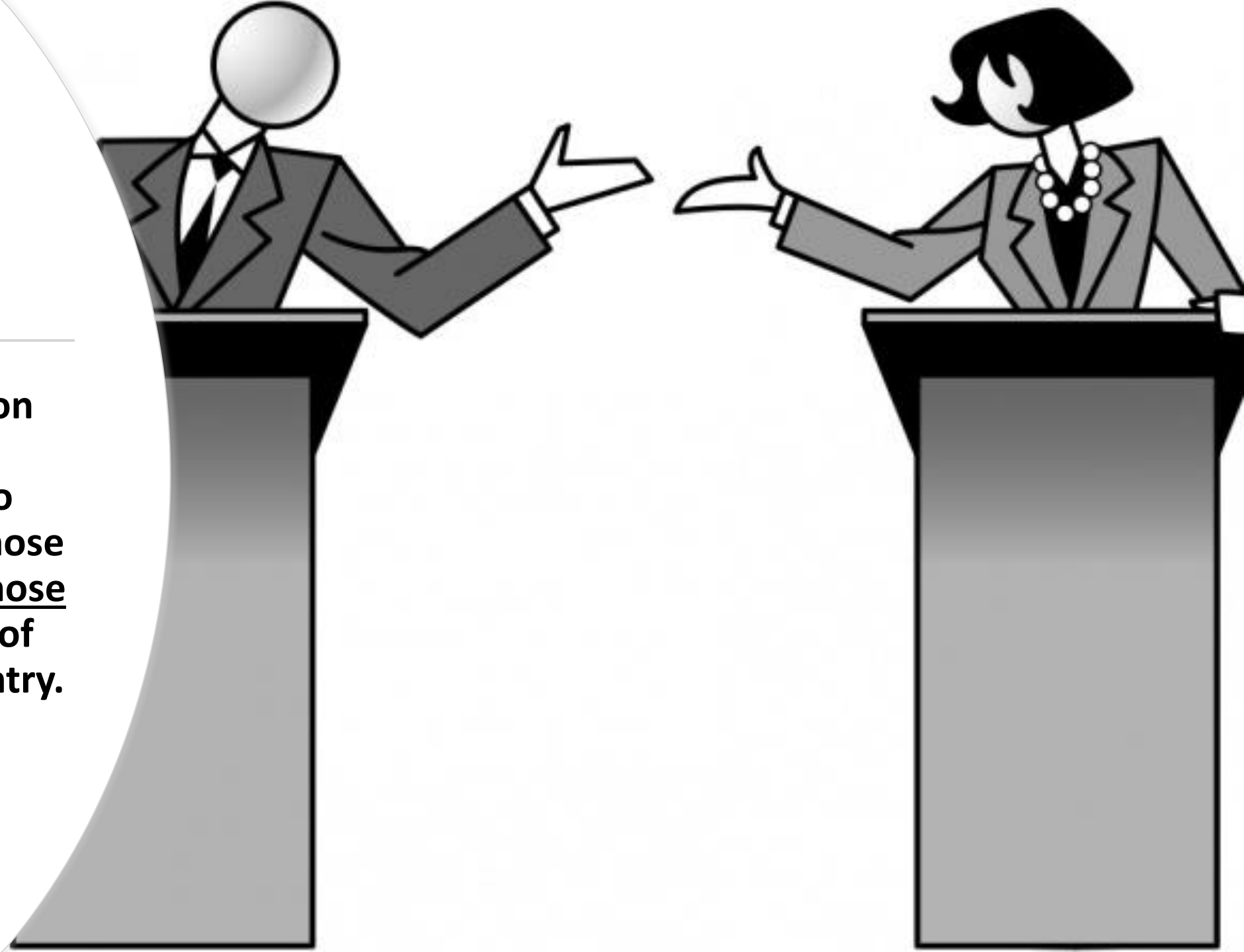
