Girls took part in the shoe competition!





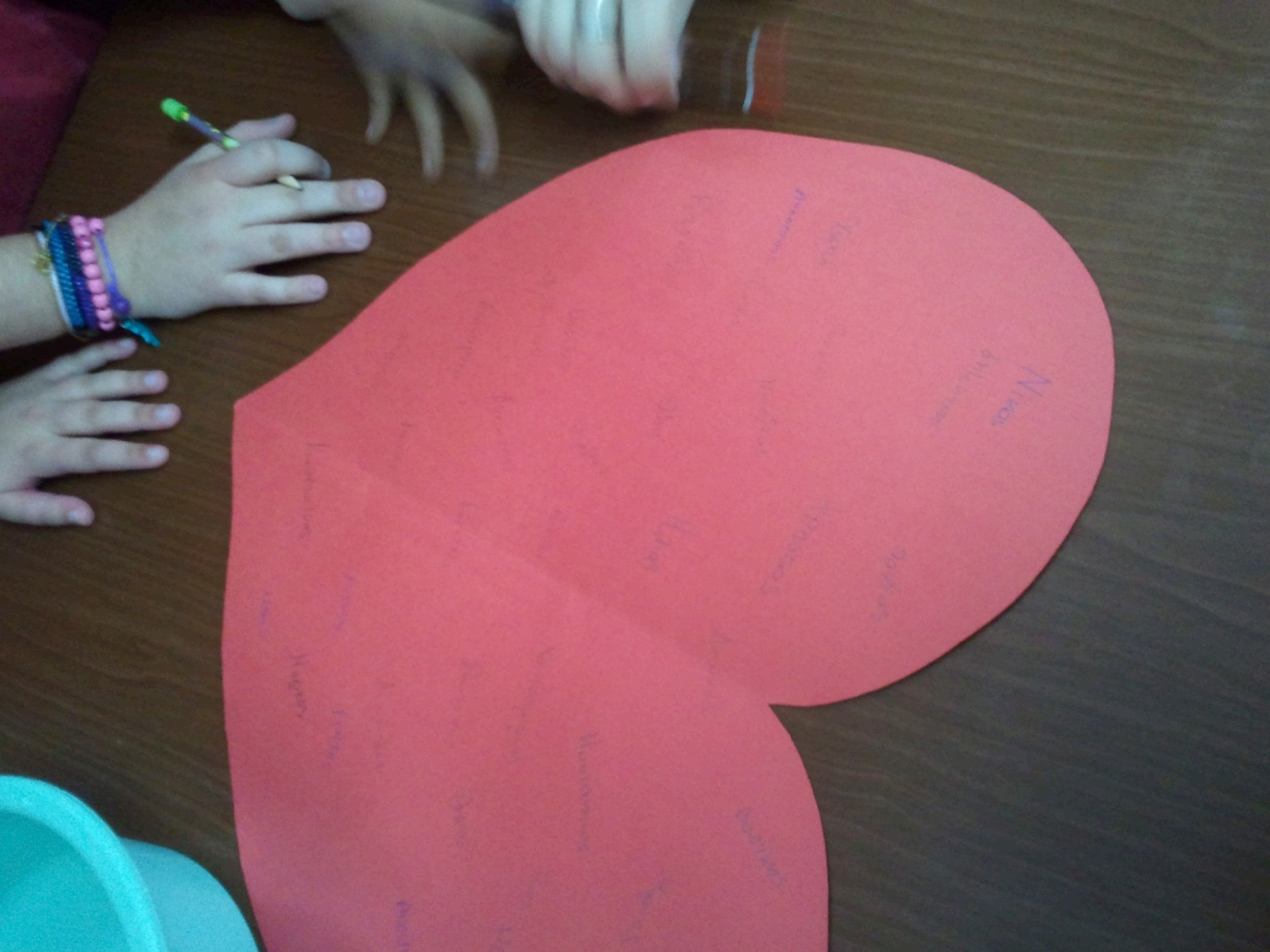






We wrote names on paper hearts!
