PRESENTATION OF OUR SCHOOL

Our School –the 8th Primary School of Leivadia is housed in a building complex of 6 buildings (per 2 buildings on three uneven levels) built in 1990. There is no care for people with mobility problems although there are different levels.

This school year there were 12 departments (6 classes), SPA reception department, Integration department and 183 students attended them.

The permanent teachers in our school are sixteen (16) - twelve (12) organic and four (4) were available, the Deputy Teachers were ten (10)

The support staff consists of two (2) people, a cleaner with a fixed-term contract who takes care of the cleanliness of our school and the tenant of the school canteen.

The school unit operates under the coordination of the principal and with the teachers collaborating in common axes in order to implement the curriculum and the educational project that is enriched with many activities.

The socio-cultural characteristics of the student potential are pure. Refugee children with very good integration study at TY-ZEP.

Teachers with personal time beyond their hours, try and succeed in responding to their educational work knowing their difficulty and great responsibility towards meeting the educational needs of students.

Parents enhance the educational processes and practices, as well as the results of the educational projects

Our school unit is highly accepted and there is great support from all parents and especially their Association, in strengthening the logistical infrastructure and educational work.

There is a two-way interaction with the wider social environment, as our school unit participates in local actions and is supported by local agencies.
