Examples

I like chocolate. They like the zoo. We like vegetables.

Remember!

Add an 's' for she, he and it. She likes apples. He likes the park. It likes warm water.

Be careful!

For negatives add 'don't' or 'doesn't'.

I **don't like** chocolate. He **doesn't like** the zoo. They **don't like** vegetables.


