It likes warm water.

Be careful!

For negatives add 'don't' or 'doesn't'.
*I **don't like** chocolate.*
*He **doesn't like** the zoo.*
*They **don't like** vegetables.*

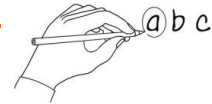


Like and don't like

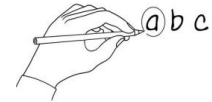
