
## KLISTHENIS ESTABLISHES DEMOCRACY

We refer to important people of that era (of that time). We met till now and we write them down on a piece of paper.




We make a tableau (a board) with the events as well as the most important legislators (law-makers) of that period.




We learn Klisthenis's new important personality, who was exiled during Pisistratus's tyranny.




We understand the changes that Klisthenis brought in the organization of the society and the administration of the state with the aid of the pictures in the book.



We write down Klisthenis's important changes and we, especially, emphasize the power of the Church of the Municipality (the people).




Looking at pictures in the book, we discuss about ostracism, an important basic measure for the protection of Democracy.
