Choose **one book** from the school **foreign-language library**, read it carefully and then show your ideas and imagination by creating a **project** inspired by the book.

You can choose **one** of the following:


🎨 Create a **poster or illustration** inspired by the book

✉ Write a **letter to the author** sharing your thoughts and feelings

🎬 Make a **book trailer** (1–2 minutes) to promote the book to your classmates


✍ “If I were the hero...” – write a new ending


🎙 Record a **podcast** reading an extract from the book

 **Create a comic strip** based on one scene or the whole story

 **Create a story map** with settings, characters, and main events

 **Create character profiles** with descriptions, traits, and relationships

 **Write a book review** with evaluation and personal opinion

 **Create a quiz or a game** based on the content of the book

 **Design an alternative book cover** with a title and a short blurb on the back cover.

 **Write an article or an interview** (e.g. an interview with the main character).

 **Home books are welcome!**

You may also present a book from home that is **not** in the school library.

Your project **must** include:

- the **title** of the book
- the **author**
- the **main characters**
- the **plot summary**
- a **photo of the book cover**

**Be creative, have fun, and make the story your own!**

## Email Sending Instructions

### 1. Log in to your email account

Open Gmail, Outlook, Yahoo, or any other email service you use.


### 2. Create a new message

Click “**Compose**”, “**New Message**”, or “**New Email.**”

### 3. Fill in the details

- **Recipient (To):** **agpolixrono@sch.gr**
- **Subject:** *Project – Books Come To Life!*
- **Message body:** A nickname, your name, surname, and the title of your work.

### 4. Attach the file

- Click on the **paperclip icon** () or “**Attach file.**”
- Select the file from your computer or mobile device.
- Wait for the upload to finish.

### 5. Check before sending

- Make sure the file is attached correctly.
- Check the recipient and the message.

Click “**Send.**”
