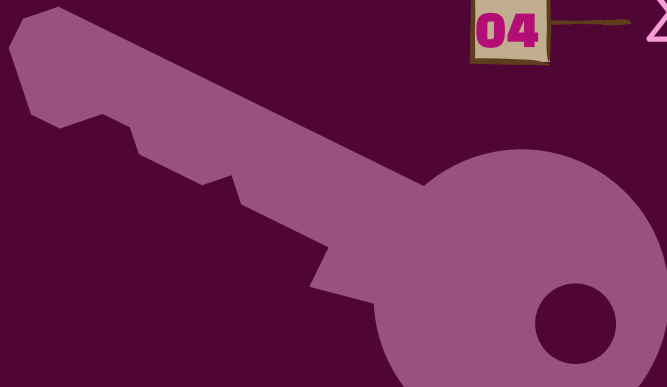

According to Wikipedia **philhellenism** was an intellectual movement prominent mostly at the turn of the 19th century. It contributed to the sentiments that led Europeans such as Lord Byron to advocate for the independence of the Greek people from the Ottomans.



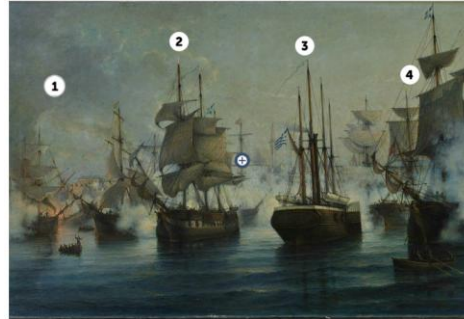
Eugene Delacroix: Massacre at Chios

A very strong movement of Philhellenism flourished in many countries around the world. The outcome of the war might have been completely different if it hadn't been for the help and support of its followers who came and fought on the Greeks' side and/or sent money and supplies that saved the lives of thousands of Greeks.

Many artists tried to support the Greeks using their art as a means to convey their message across Europe.

Lord Byron is considered a main figure of philhellenism. His poetry, along with Eugene Delacroix's painting, helped arouse European public opinion in favour of the Greek revolutionary cause and led Western powers to intervene directly.
