

“THE BRITISH MUSEUM”

The British Museum was established on 7 June 1753 and it's located in Great Russel Street in the Bloomsbury area, London. Its collection has approximately 8 million objects that are dedicated to human history, art, and culture. There are more than 94 galleries that contain 2,000,000 individual objects entries. There are 4,000 objects in the museum that are the “highlights” database entries.

There are also 10 departments:

1. Department of Egypt and Sudan
2. Department of Greece and Rome
3. Department of the Middle East
4. Department of Prints and Drawings
5. Department of Britain, Europe, and Prehistory
6. Department of Asia
7. Department of Africa, Oceania and the Americas
8. Department of Coins and Medals
9. Department of Conservation and Scientific Research
10. Libraries and archives

In 2020 the British Museum accepted 1,275,400 people. The 2 most popular exhibitions are:

- “Ice Age Art”
