The London Dungeon is a tourist attraction that recreates scary and gory events from history with special effects, rides, and live actors. It is located on London's South Bank, a short walk from Waterloo mainline and London Underground stations.

It is open every day of the week except Christmas Day. Also, the opening hours change during the year. A guided tour in the London Dungeon costs 28 pounds per person but, if you pre-book as a group of 10 or more, you can get a discount. The London Dungeon experience is a 90- minute walk, but it's recommended for 60- 75 minutes.

The London Dungeon was established as a tourist attraction in 1974. Now, it's become one of the city's most famous places to visit. There, you will see dungeons and you can take part in the highlights of London's history, guided by professional actors. Also, it is scary to most people, except for a handful of them who find it funny.

There is no age limit, although it is recommended for children over 12.
