47 AD Londinium is founded by the Romans

60 AD Boudica's forces invade and destroy Londinium

122 AD Londinium is visited by the Roman Emperor Hadrian



140 AD Londinium is inhabited by about 50.000 people

140-150 AD Londinium develops a sewage drainage system, also having piped water

190-225 AD The London Wall is under construction

197 AD Britain divided into an upper and lower unit, after a rebellion, led by Clodius Albinus (Roman commander), who was defeated by a rival commander. Londinium becomes the capital of the lower unit.



214 AD Londinium becomes the capital of Britannia (a Roman province).

255 AD A defensive wall along the Thames shore of Londinium is erected.

288 AD The formation of a Britannic Empire is declared by Carausius who also secures allies in Britain and among the Franks in Gaul.

293-296 AD Allectus declares a rebellion, but in 296, he is defeated by the emperor's forces.

340 AD The Celtic tribes of the Picts and Gaels attack the northern borders of Roman Britain.

382-388 AD Magnus Maximus declares himself emperor of the Western Roman Empire, but in 388 he is also defeated.

In the 5th century, the Saxons took advantage of the tensions in Britain and gained control of London.
