The Cathedral's History

The Cathedral's construction started in 1675 and

was completed in 1710. It was designed by Sir Christopher Wren in 1669. Christopher Wren is one of the most world-renowned British architects of all time, having also designed the Greenwich Observatory, the Kensington Palace, the Malborough House etc. The Cathedral stands at a mind-blowing 111m! That would make it the tallest building in London from 1710 to 1963.

Today, the Cathedral still stands as one of the most prominent buildings in the London skyline welcoming over 1,500,000 million visitors yearly!
