Historical Background:

- Built by William the Conqueror in 1078
- Originally a Norman fortress to control London.

Key Features:

- White Tower (the central keep)
- Ravens (superstition says the kingdom will fall if they leave)
- Crown Jewels (still housed there today)
- Yeoman Warders (aka "Beefeaters," the ceremonial guards)
