- 1. Miguel de Cervantes was a Spanish novelist, playwright and poet. He is best known for his **novel** Don Quixote, the most famous **figure** in Spanish literature.
- 2. Cervantes was born in 1547 in a town near Madrid. In his early twenties, he studied for a few years and then he became a **soldier**. In 1571, he fought in the sea **battle** at Lepanto and received a **wound** that permanently **crippled** his left hand. He was proud of his **role** in the famous **victory**.
- 3.In 1575, he **set out** for Spain with his brother, Roderigo. Turkish pirates **captured** the ship and the brothers were taken to Algiers as **slaves**. Two years later, Roderigo was freed on **ransom**. Five years later, in 1580, the family raised money for his ransom too. Cervantes returned to Madrid and began to write.
- 4. In 1585, his first **major** work, Galatea, received little attention. For twenty years he lived like a **nomad**. His short stories, Exemplary Tales, contained some of his best work about love, ideals and **gypsy** life. He wrote Don Quixote while he was in prison at Argamasilla in La Mancha. Readers loved the everyday language. The **international acclaim** of the novel did not change his financial situation and he remained poor for the rest of his life.
- 5. In 1606, he moved permanently to Madrid. He died poor on April 23,1616.
