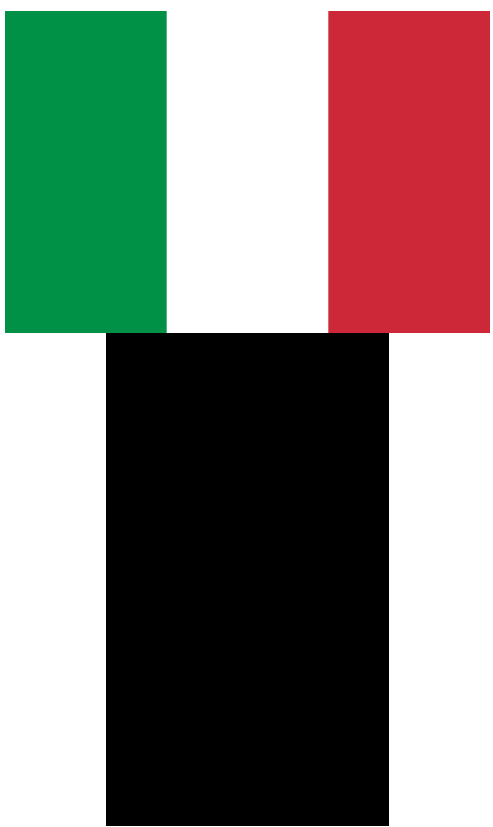


How to spot Fake news



Check the Source

Make sure the news comes from a reliable and well-known source, such as reputable newspapers, websites, or journalistic outlets. Unknown or unverified sources often signal fake news.

Analyze the Content

Check the language: Fake news often uses sensational or emotional language to provoke strong reactions. If the article seems exaggerated or too dramatic, it might be false.

Check the Date and Context

Fake news may involve outdated stories or use old events presented as if they're happening now. Check when the article was published to ensure it's relevant and up-to-date.
