We also saw the famous Greek submarine "Papanikolis" which belonged to the Hellenic Navy and took part in the World War II. It took its name in honour of Dimitrios Papanikolis who was a fire alighter from Psara island in 1821 Greek Revolution against the Turks.

We were also impressed by the fact that a daily diary is kept by the captain of every ship. So we took a picture of such a diary of a war ship dating back in the sea battles of the 1821 Revolution.
