

Art Review Writing Steps

A review of a work of art must consist of several points:

- Analyze the features of the composition of the painting. Pay special attention to what is depicted in the foreground and what is attributed to the background by the painter. Describe in detail the various details: the number of characters in the painting, their poses and emotions, the presence of landscapes and objects.
- Summarize its main theme, what it is devoted to. Note whether the painting is related to certain events from the artist's life, and whether it bears associations with any artistic movement. Determine exactly what the painter wanted to express.
- Express your own impression of the painting. Explain how exactly it impressed you, to what thoughts it pushed, and what associations it caused.
- Describe the feelings evoked by the painting.
