- To be between 8 12 years old.

Expenses: The expenses to and from Greece, as well as the accommodation and outdoor/ indoor activities are covered by the GSGA.

Duration: 20day camping period in July

Program: The program includes:

- Learning courses of the Greek language.
- Visits of historical and archaeological places and museums.
- Teaching of traditional dances.
- Attending of musical events, theatrical shows etc.
