DURATION / TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

- **1. a.** The scholarship for <u>Postgraduate Doctoral studies</u>, <u>Specialization in the Fine Arts or Collection of Research Data</u> begins after the candidate's arrival in Greece provided that you have: (i) been accepted by a School of Modern Greek Language (the courses usually start in October for further information you have to apply to the relevant Universities); and (ii) been admitted to a Greek University to pursue the respective studies as proved by a formal letter issued by the relevant University Department.
- **b.** For <u>Postdoctoral Studies</u>, the scholarship begins after the candidate's arrival in Greece, provided that a Greek University professor has accepted to cooperate with you during your postdoctoral research studies.
- **c.** For <u>Further Education Studies</u> in Greek Language, Literature, Philosophy and Art, the scholarship begins after the candidate's arrival in Greece, provided that a Greek University professor has accepted to supervise you during your research work.

Candidates are responsible for the commencement of their scholarship and are requested to provide the I.K.Y the supporting documentation (acceptance letter).

It is highly recommended that you have adequate financial provision to cover immediate needs, because due to standard procedures the first payment of the scholarship will be ready <u>almost 3 weeks after your arrival in Greece and the submission of the required documents.</u>

- 2. Details for the duration of each scholarship are mentioned in the announcement of the programme.
 - The scholarship is for a consecutive period of time. No scholarship can start during the summer.
- Scholarship holders of all categories should submit to the I.K.Y. each semester (6 months period) a studies report signed by their supervisor.

At the end of the first year, scholars <u>for Postgraduate / Doctoral Studies or Specialization in the Fine Arts</u> have to submit to this Foundation the following documents:

- a) A certificate from the school of Modern Greek Language indicating the successful completion of the course.
- **b**) An annual studies report written and signed by them and signed by their supervisor.
- c) An certificate from the relevant University Department indicating the title (topic) of their thesis and the three members supervisory committee (where Doctoral Studies are concerned) or transcripts of the postgraduate courses attended (where Postgraduate Studies for a second Master's are concerned) and
- d) A letter from the academic supervisor(s) recommending the renewal of their scholarship.

In the following year(s), the scholars have to submit to the I.K.Y. all the above mentioned documents except for (a).

<u>Postdoctoral and Further Education scholars</u> should submit the documents (b) and (d) at the end of the first semester. The documents set out above are absolutely necessary for the renewal of the scholarship.

At the end of their course programme, scholarship holders should submit a detailed final report signed by their academic supervisor(s) and a certified copy of the academic qualification they have acquired, if any.

Scholars for the category of <u>Collection of Research Data</u> should submit at the end of their course programme (1 year only) the above mentioned documents a) and b). There is no possibility for renewal in this category of scholarship.

The terms and conditions of the scholarship are mentioned in detail in the contract concluded between each scholar and the I.K.Y.

- 3. The I.K.Y. is entitled to immediately end the scholarship in the event scholarship holders:
 - a) Have made a false statement on their application file.
 - b) Do not comply with the terms and conditions of the scholarship.
 - c) Hold a scholarship from another source at the same time.
 - **d**) Have been subjected to disciplinary action by the University or have no prospect for academic achievement (e.g. failure to achieve a satisfactory level in the Greek language or in their major field of studies).
 - e) Leave Greece -regardless of the reason- without having previously informed in writing this Foundation.
- **4.** Applicants who are or have been scholarship holders of this Foundation will be excluded from all future programmes of I.K.Y.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

All scholarships provide:

a) A monthly allowance of €500,00 for living expenses.

For postdoctoral researchers and professors from Greek Studies University Departments abroad this amounts to $\le 650,00$. The amount of the scholarship does not cover the full cost of living but it is a financial aid towards the scholar's monthly expenses. The estimated cost of living is $\le 650,00 - \$800,00$ per month approximately.

- **b**) €600,00 for initial expenses.
- c) Exemption from tuition fees for the School of Modern Greek Language.
- d) Free medical care in public hospitals in case of emergency.

The scholarship for <u>Doctoral Studies</u> includes up to $\leq 300,00$ to cover typing and reproduction costs of the Ph.D. dissertation and up to $\leq 300,00$ to cover laboratory expenses, if such expenses are a mandatory part of the scholar's doctoral programme of studies.

- No support is provided for travel, conferences, seminars, symposia or research activities.
- No additional assistance is provided for the spouse or other dependants of the scholarship holder.
- The scholarship holder is not permitted to undertake paid employment of any kind, as they are expected to devote themselves fully to their studies.
- The scholarship will be withheld for periods spent outside Greece.
