Classroom Activities

0-10 min Students will break into three groups and will discuss their answers related to the presentation

10-30 min Ask students about the research they made at home related to Seizures and Neurology in general

30-50 min Students write a small essay about Neurology based on the Research they made at home,

keeping it as simple as they can

50-60 min Students make a small questionnaire about Seizures

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Assessment
Diagnostic Assessment :Before class, check if students have watched the presentation
Formative Assessment: Walk around the classroom and ask students about their knowledge of Neurology before watching the video, divide them into three groups and ask them to perform a free dialogue about Seizures and Neurology in general and how the presentation improved their previous knowledge
Summative Assessment:Distribute post quiz with general questions about Neurology
