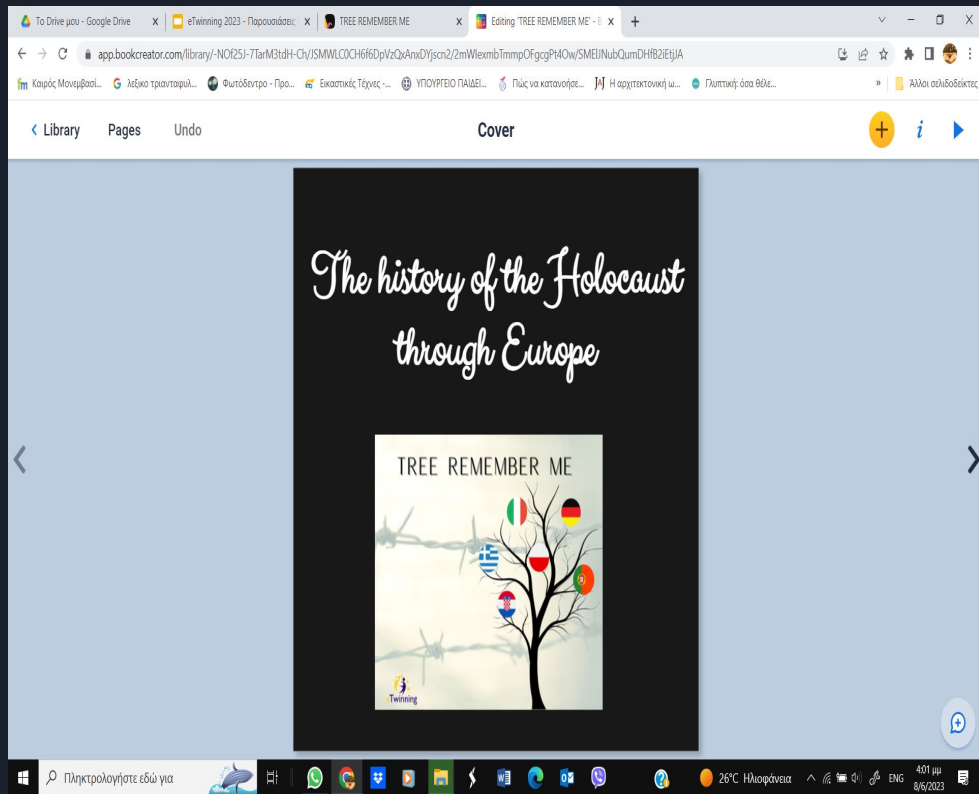

Today's historiography has no reliable documentation. Croatia reports do not keep records of all concentration camps. On the other hand, a heavy share of mass murders have not been explored. Also, Ustaša regime tried to cover up crimes every possible way: bodies were thrown away in the Adriatic Sea or rivers.</p> <p>27</p>	<p>28</p> <p>Prominent persons</p> <p>Ample Bogdanac was the founder of Greek Jewish community in Athens. <p>31</p> <p>POLITICAL CONDITIONS IN GREECE BEFORE THE SECOND WORLD WAR</p> <p>The political condition in Greece in 1930s was interesting. George II appointed as prime minister Ioannis Metaxas. Known for his anti-democratic ideas, his appointment led to strong reactions, culminating in the bloody demonstrations in Thessaloniki in May 1936. Under the pretext of these events and citing "communist danger", George II and Metaxas declared a dictatorship on 4th August 1936, on the eve of a bloody four-hour electoral vote.</p> <p>The dream of I. Metaxas was the creation of Greece of a regime according to the standards of fascist Italy and Nazi Germany. However, there was no fascist party in Greece. The dictator tried to fill the void by creating the National Youth Organization (ENY), but World War II interrupted his attempt.</p> <p>31</p>	<p>32</p> <p>At the same time, he tried to affiliate the farmers and workers with systematic propaganda and with the adoption of certain socio-economic measures (regulation of agricultural debts, cooperation of the social insurance foundations). The August 19th regime never gained strong social support. In this sense it differed from fascist and Italian. Metaxas limited himself to organizing an authoritarian state that persecuted his opponents, especially the communists. Finally, with regard to Greece's international position, Metaxas, under the decisive influence of King George II, oriented himself from the beginning towards Great Britain, considering that in the event of war, Britain would be the winner.</p>  <p>Ioannis Metaxas</p> <p>32</p>	<p>33</p> <p>SECOND WORLD WAR IN GREECE</p> <p>On October 28, Italy demanded that troops be allowed to enter Greece. Metaxas refused and so the war of the people and the Italian invasion began. On the one hand, the fighting in the Italian invasion began. On the other hand, German attacks from Yugoslavia and Bulgarian territories. The Germans broke the brave Greek resistance and Lieutenant General Tsolomou signed a capitulation on his own initiative. The official Greek government moves to Crete and the country is divided into three zones of occupation: German, Bulgarian and Italian. Repressive measures are imposed, financial resources are frozen and mass executions are carried out. The first important resistance movement was the launching of the Soufli Flag from the Acropolis on May 30, 1941 by two students: Maria Goussa and Anastasia Surlis, an action that damaged the prestige of the occupiers.</p> <p>33</p>	<p>34</p> <p>At the same time, resistance organizations are formed that act against the occupiers and deal with the aim of ensuring the ability of the Greeks to choose for themselves the form of government of their country after the liberation. <p>37</p> <p>During World War II, when the Italians invaded the island, the Jewish population in Greece increased during the Roman years and formed the basis of Jewish settlements during the Byzantine era. Their main occupations were weaving, tanning, dyeing and silk making. These Jews, later called Romaniotes, were Greek-speaking and significantly intermingled into Greek culture. It is characteristic that they wrote in Greek, but using the Hebrew alphabet.
