- Η 26η Σεπτεμβρίου είναι ημέρα αφιερωμένη στον εορτασμό των γλωσσών.
- Ο εορτασμός της **Ευρωπαϊκής Ημέρας Γλωσσών** στις **26 Σεπτεμβρίου**, καθιερώθηκε με απόφαση της Επιτροπής Υπουργών του **Συμβουλίου της Ευρώπης** (*Council of Europe*) στις 6η Δεκεμβρίου 2001.
- Εφέτος, συμπληρώνονται **είκοσι χρόνια** από την καθιέρωση του εορτασμού της.
- Κάθε χρόνο, την ημερομηνία αυτή ενώνουν τη φωνή τους το **Συμβούλιο της Ευρώπης** (*Council of Europe*), το **Ευρωπαϊκό Κέντρο Σύγχρονων Γλωσσών** (*European Center for Modern Languages*) και η **Ευρωπαϊκή Επιτροπή** (*European Commission*) με σχολεία, Πανεπιστήμια, γλωσσικά ινστιτούτα, εκπαιδευτικούς, μαθητές, φοιτητές και απλούς πολίτες απ' όλη την Ευρώπη αλλά και όλον τον κόσμο για να εορτάσουν τη γλωσσική πολυμορφία, διοργανώνοντας ποικίλες εκδηλώσεις.
- Οι γλώσσες αποτελούν πολύτιμο κομμάτι της παγκόσμιας πολιτιστικής κληρονομιάς, που οφείλουμε να διαφυλάξουμε, να καλλιεργήσουμε και να αναδείξουμε.
- Χρησιμεύουν ως γέφυρες επικοινωνίας με άλλους πολιτισμούς, προάγοντας την αμοιβαία κατανόηση, την αλληλεγγύη και την κοινωνική συνοχή και διευκολύνουν την πρόσβαση σε αγαθά και υπηρεσίες.
- Το **Υπουργείο Παιδείας και Θρησκευμάτων** συμμετέχει ενεργά στο έργο του Συμβουλίου της Ευρώπης (*Council of Europe*) και ειδικότερα του Ευρωπαϊκού Κέντρου Σύγχρονων Γλωσσών (*European Center for Modern Languages – ECML*), Οργανισμού του Συμβουλίου της Ευρώπης, ο οποίος προωθεί την ποιοτική διδασκαλία και εκμάθηση των γλωσσών για όλους τους μαθητές, αδιακρίτως.

2. You can use up to 3 colours.
3. If you have versions using different colours, send all of them in one email, we will select the ones that we like the most.
4. Keep in mind that we need a simple design that is not too complex or that has small details. This will increase printing quality.
5. The design cannot go over the seams of the t-shirt, it must be placed on the front. Keep in mind that the maximum printing surface is 30 cm x 30 cm
6. The design cannot contain third party copyright logos or material.
7. By sending us the design you agree that we can use it free of charge on our websites, on the t-shirts and on promotional media (such as Facebook or flyers). Of course, we will always add your name to it.

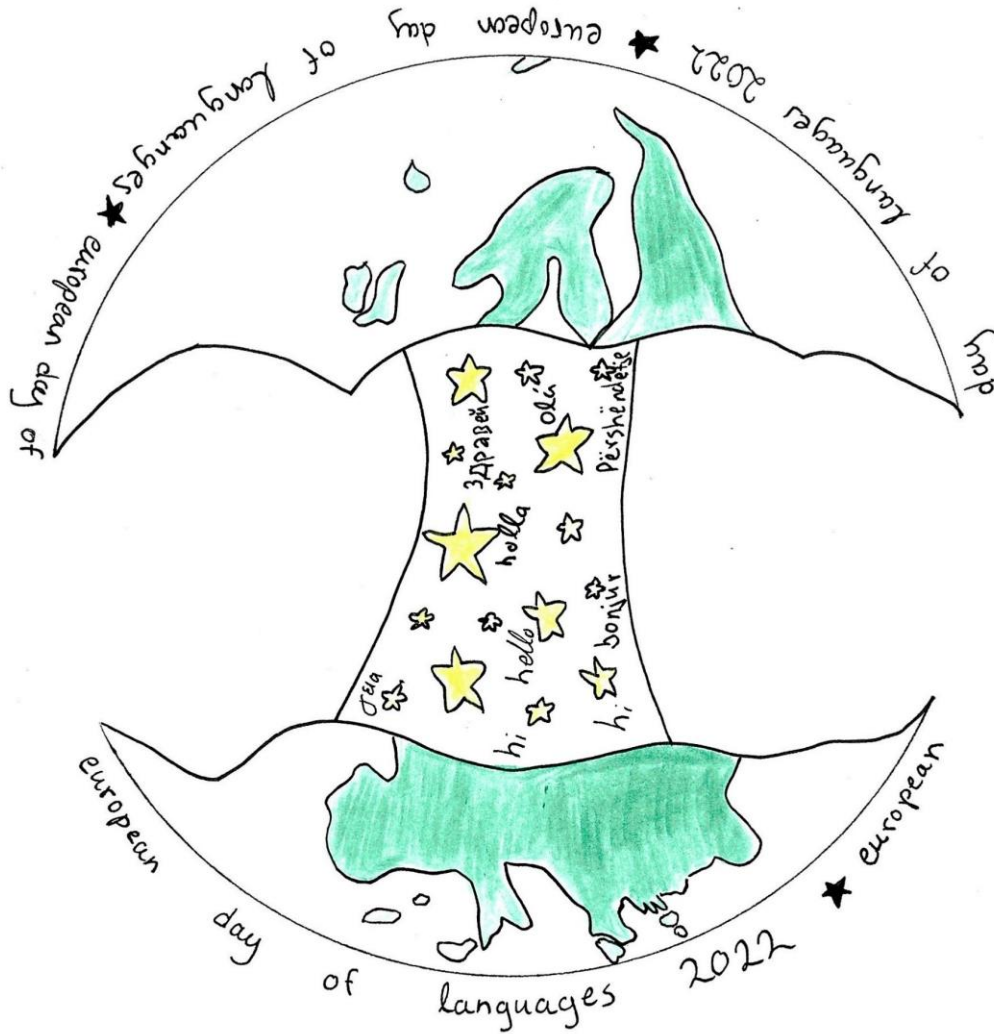

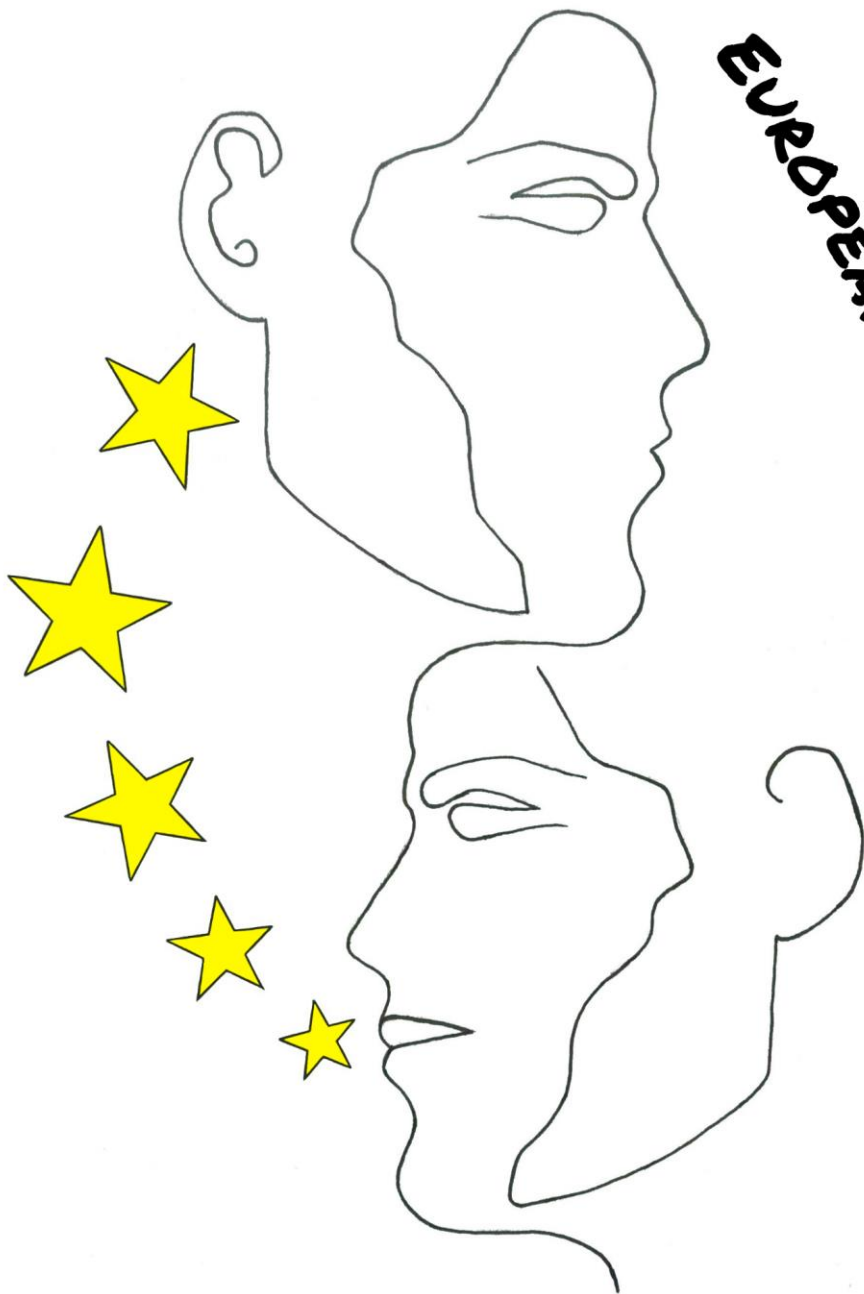

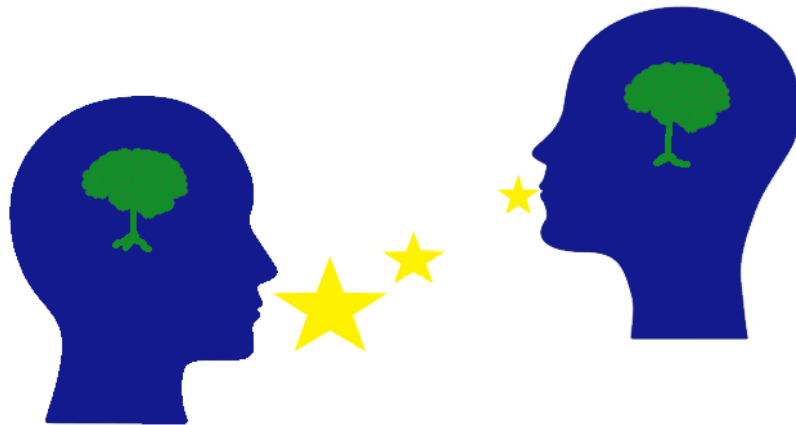
ELENA KAPLANI B2

I like drawing faces even if they are not perfect. The idea of my design started with the map of Europe. I think this is a simple and nice way to show how our different languages connect us.

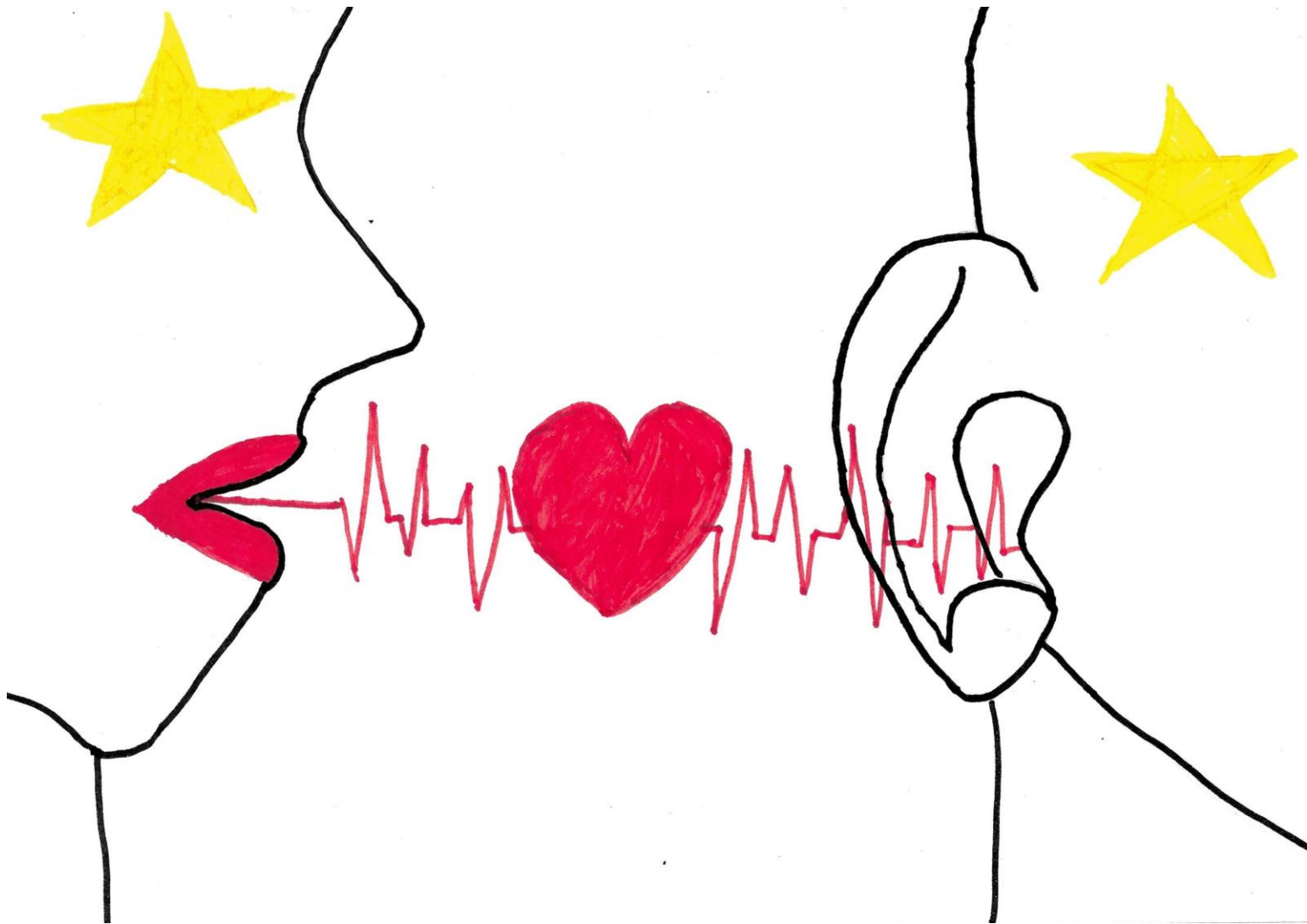

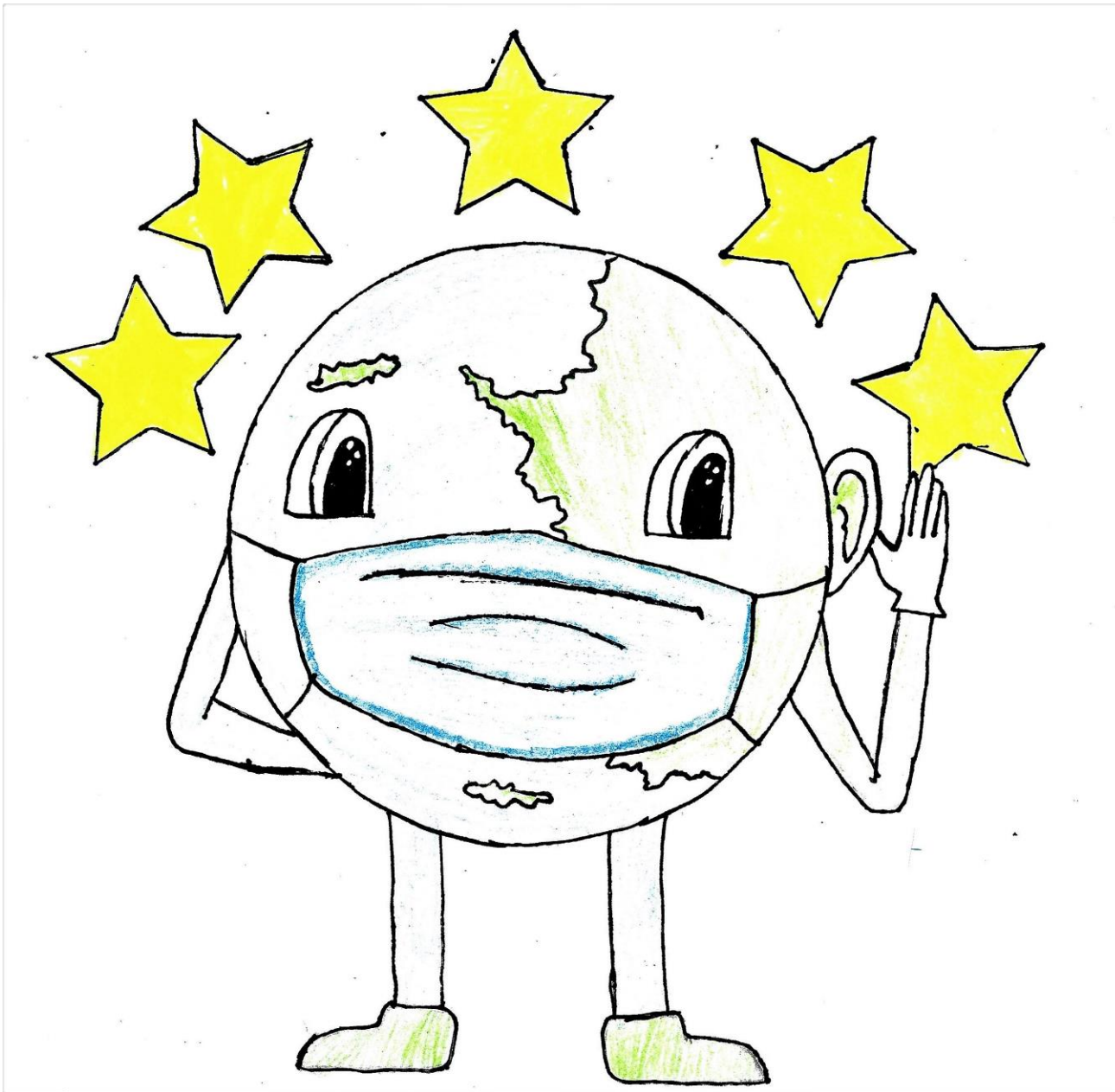

I'm Anna Kanellou and I created this painting to show that we must say words of love and have respect for each other.



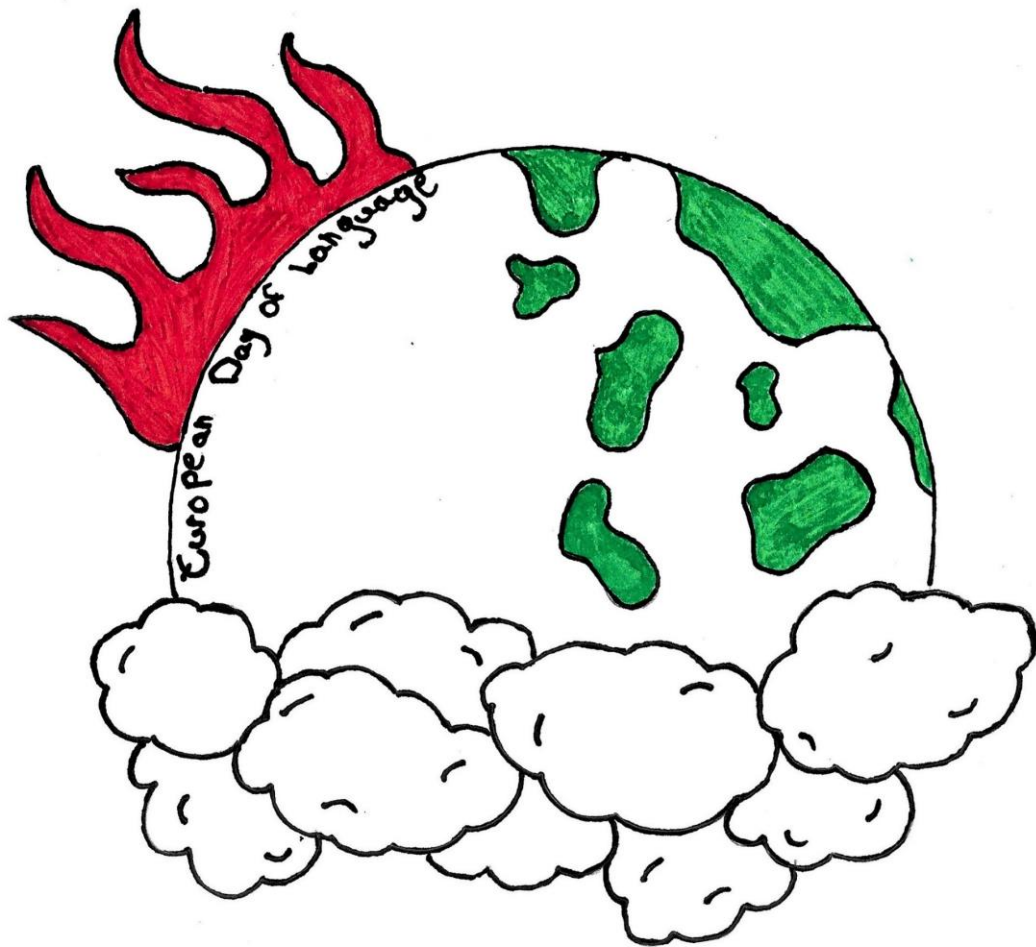

Language is a medium of communication and a bridge among people of all countries.

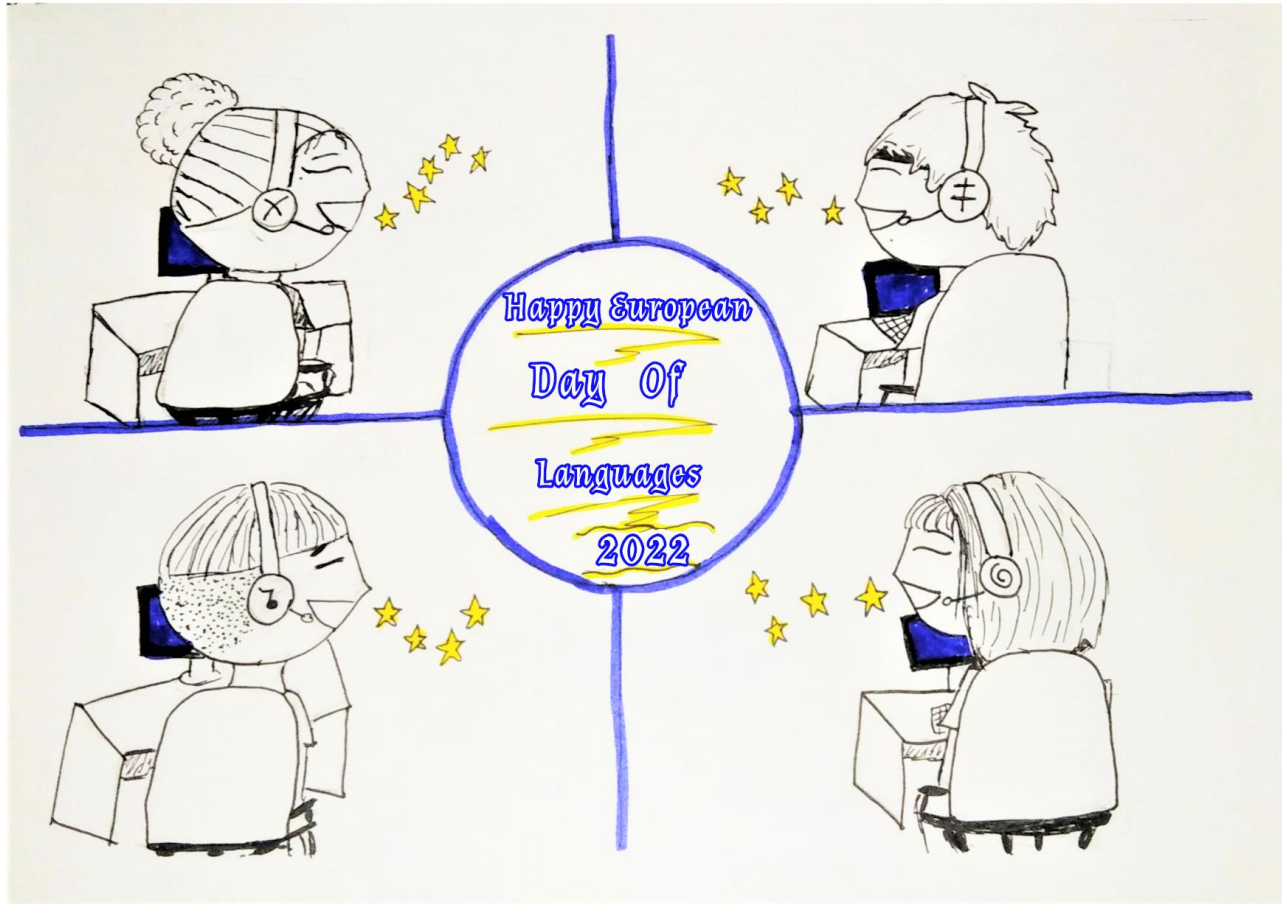

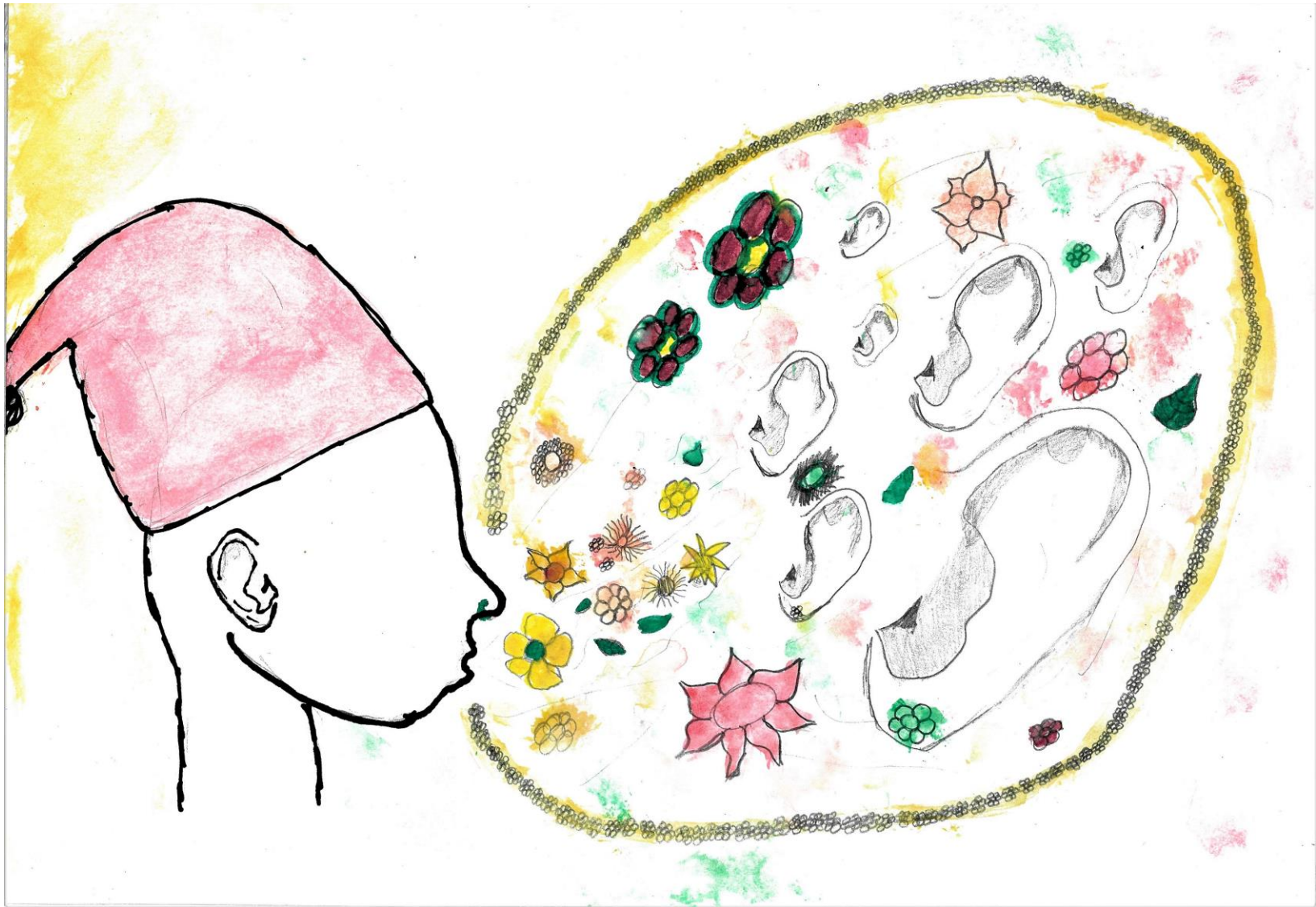
MARIA ΚΑΡΑΓΙΑΝΝΙΔΟΥ

My name is Nikoleta and I come from Greece. I like to draw and the topic of communication of the countries of Europe through language gained my interest. Language brightens our lives.

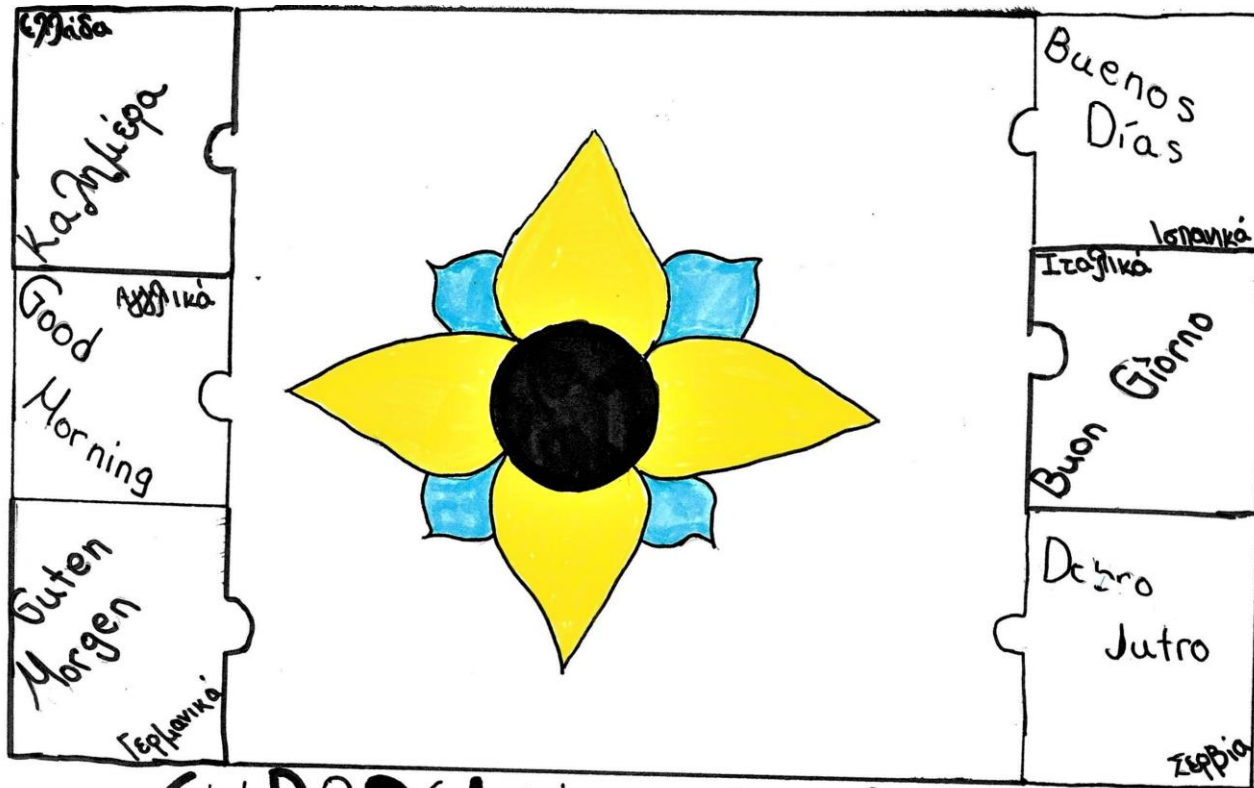

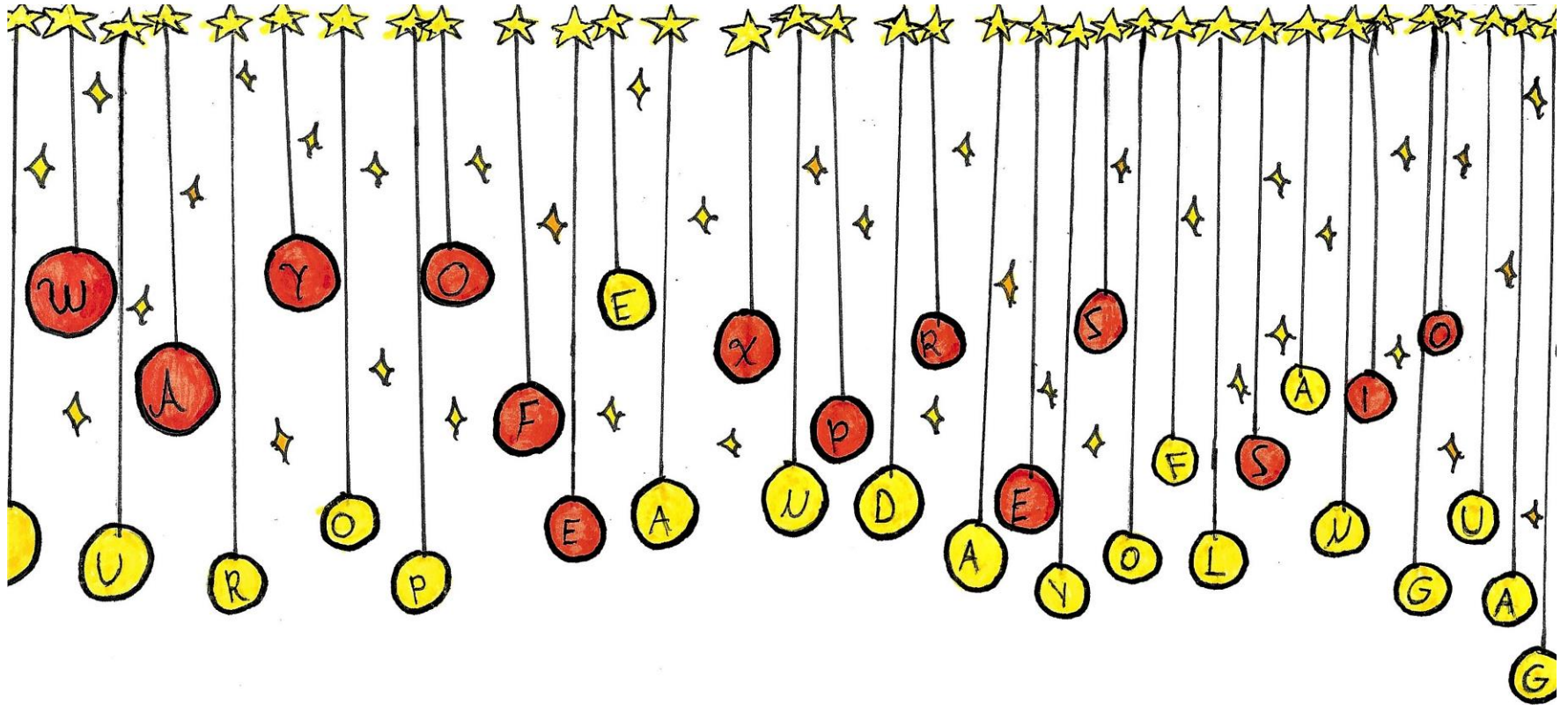

Oxygen gives us life and with language we **“breathe”**.

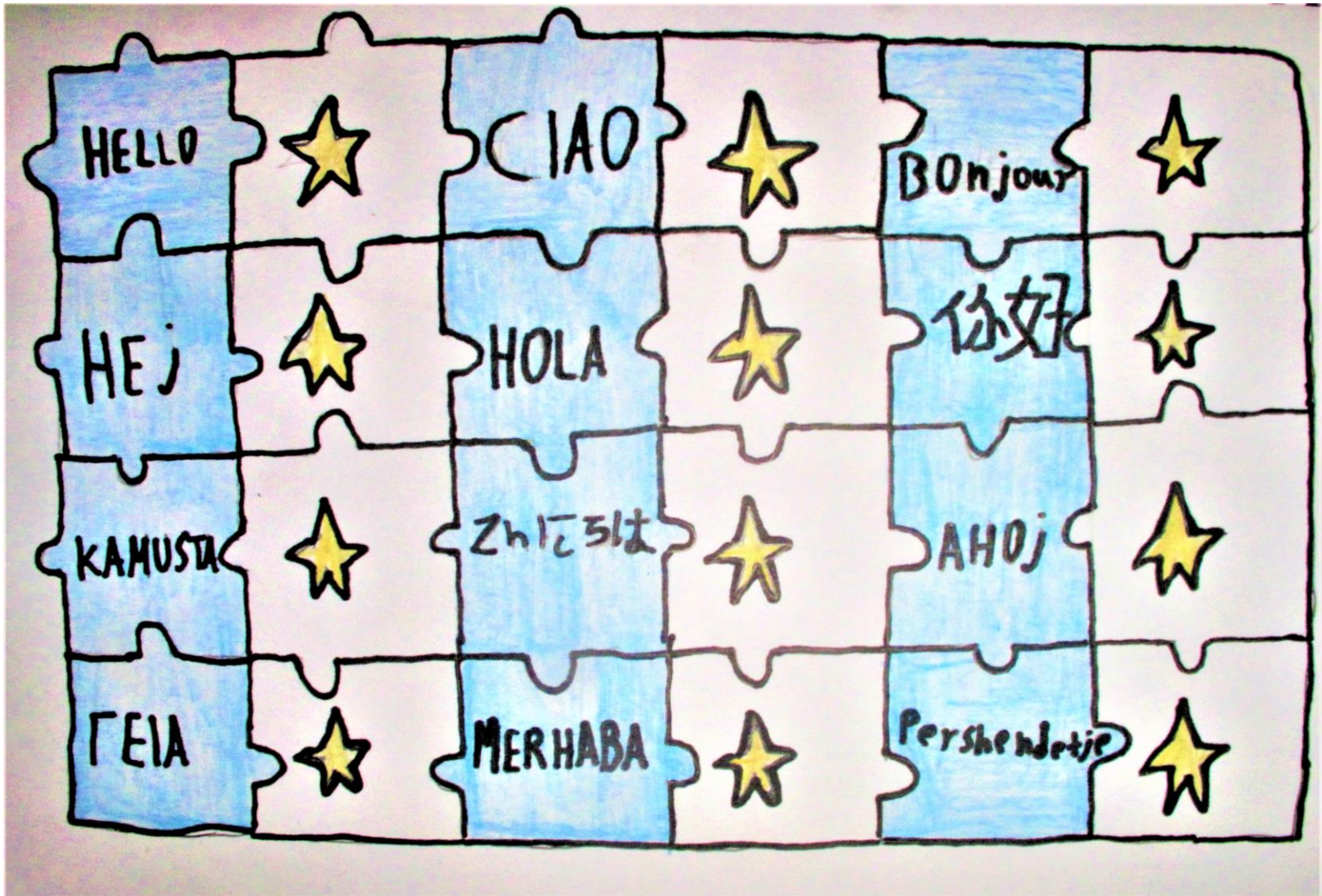
