Affirmative

Interrogative (question)

I was sleeping Was I sleeping? You were sleeping Were you sleeping? He was sleeping Was he sleeping? She was sleeping Was she sleeping? It was sleeping Was it sleeping? We were sleeping Were we sleeping? You were sleeping Were you sleeping? They were sleeping Were they sleeping? I wasn't sleeping
You weren't sleeping
He wasn't sleeping
She wasn't sleeping
It wasn't sleeping
We weren't sleeping
You weren't sleeping
They weren't sleeping

Short answers

Were they watching TV last night? Yes, they were.

Yes, I was. / No, I wasn't.

..

Yes, you were. / No, you weren't.

Yes, he / she / it was. / No, he / she / it wasn't.

Πότε χρησιμοποιούμε Past Continuous?

Για μια πράξη που γινόταν (που ήταν σε εξέλιξη) κάποια χρονική στιγμή στο παρελθόν.

I was doing my homework at eight o'clock yesterday evening.

He was working hard all morning.

Για δυο ή περισσότερες πράξεις που γινόταν ταυτόχρονα στο παρελθόν
Mum was doing the housework and the children were playing.



- Για να περιγράψουμε το σκηνικό μιας ιστορίας
- e.g. It was a splendid morning. The sun was shining bright and the birds were singing in the trees.



Past Continuous and Simple Past

Χρησιμοποιούμε τον **Past Continuous** και τον **Simple Past** μαζί όταν περιγράφουμε μια πράξη που συνέβαινε στο παρελθόν και διακόπηκε από μια άλλη πράξη.

I was sleeping when the phone rang.



e.g. When I got home, my friends were waiting.

She left the house while I was sleeping.
