THE NUMBERS OF TIE2015

The official launch of the project took place on Oct. 6th, 2014. Since then the community was animated by 2,792 teams from over 72 countries. 117 missions were launched, resulting in 30,328 projects submitted. The most played mission was "Your vegetable garden" (attended by 1,345 teams), followed by the quiz "World Water game". The most intense period of play was March 2015, with 5,341 works submitted.

Within the Community of TIE2015 over 22,438 messages were exchanged between teams and the hashtag #tie2015 was used for 25,445 shares on Instagram.

We would like to thank you for taking part with your students in **the international competition TIE2015** associated to the digital project "*TOGETHER IN EXPO 2015*" www.togetherinexpo2015.it that involved **638 classes** from all over the world who have been realizing multimedia works about the themes of Expo by twinning with each other's. **The interactive platform** www.togetherinexpo2015.it (usable in Italian, English and French) that allowed students and teachers to enable international twinning and begin to work and collaborate, was indeed the key element of the competition.

The **3,400** teachers registered in TOGETHER IN EXPO 2015 and the **2,700 teams / classes from 72 different countries keep competing in the COMMUNITY on a daily basis**, participating in the recreational-educational activities of *edutainment* "MISSIONS" (over **27,000** missions has been played as of 30 April 2015) and exchanging messages (over **23,000** as of 30 April 2015).

The schools' works and EXPO-experience continue not only in Milan: **Together in Expo 2015 will be active until the end of Expo Milano 2015, 31st October 2015. Your team could be the winner of the "BEST TEAM OF THE MONTH" special prize. On the 30th of each month (May, June, July, August and September), our Community managers will select the winning team: the one that will be the highest-ranking on that day (and it had not already been awarded or invited to Expo). The prize is obviously a trip to Expo!**
