




A night at the beach

- ◉ *We are organizing a night at the beach, and there we will talk about the environment.*
- ◉ ***Environment** is everything that is around us. It can be living (biotic) or non-living (abiotic) things. It includes physical, chemical and other natural forces. Living things live in their environment. They constantly interact with it and adapt themselves to conditions in their environment.*
- ◉ *In the environment there are different interactions between animals, plants, soil, water, and other living and non-living things.*



 - ◉ *People in different fields of knowledge use the word environment differently.*




environment

- ◉ *In psychology and medicine, a person's environment is the people, physical things and places that the person lives with.*
- ◉ *The environment affects the growth and development of the person.*
- ◉ *It affects the person's behavior, body, mind and heart.*



A person's environment

- A person's environment is the events and culture that the person lives in.
- Environment is everything around us.
- A person's beliefs and actions depend on his environment.
- For example Thomas Jefferson and Julius Caesar owned slaves. Modern people mostly think it is wrong to own slaves. But in Jefferson's and Caesar's *environments* slavery was normal. So, their actions did not look as wrong in their societies. Its simple definition is: Interaction between human and environment in the past.




nature versus nurture
