“European days” and “European weeks”

“European weeks” and “European days” are **privileged occasions for meetings and exchanges** between actors involved in a given area: officials in charge of developing European policies and programs, organizations from all countries, possible partners, testimonials and bearers of successful ideas.

When they take place and how to participate

Many “European weeks” are held **in the spring and fall**, which represent the most concentrated moments of this type of event. All these events are now **even more accessible** than they used to be, because they are usually organized in a hybrid form, with the possibility of attending both in-person and remotely and viewing videos and materials at the end of the event.

Όλες αυτές οι εκδηλώσεις είναι πλέον ακόμη πιο προσίτες από ό,τι ήταν παλιά, γιατί συνήθως οργανώνονται σε υβριδική μορφή, με δυνατότητα παρακολούθησης τόσο αυτοπροσώπως όσο και εξ αποστάσεως και προβολής βίντεο και υλικού στο τέλος της εκδήλωσης.

Infodays and other important events

European “days” or “weeks” do not exhaust the totality of important events organized within the framework of European projects. Even more specific and important events are the **“Infodays,”** which are sessions dedicated to the presentation of European programs, lines of action and calls for proposals, organized by the dedicated functions of [the European Commission and its Agencies](#).
