Procedure in steps	 Warm up activity. Open discourse on the issues introduced and focusing on the 'new' material of the story. Introducing the content of the digital story they are about to watch (pre-viewing) - discussion on differences. Always working in teams. Writing down the critical points the students focus on. Watching the video. Detailed questioning on the content and linking the video to the rest of the project. Ss are distributed the text and a vocabulary of the story. Watch the video once more. Discuss in teams about the story and exchange their point of view. Each team prioritizes the critical issues they've outlined in the beginning and they decide on the issue they want to work on. In-short, developing their thoughts in the form of an essay in combination to the critical issue each team decided to point out (e.g. racism, difference, social exclusion, human rights, living values).
