• αν το επίρρημα είναι ομαλό, τότε ο συγκριτικός και υπερθετικός βαθμός γίνονται περιφραστικά (more..., the most...)

Tom runs more quickly than George. Tom runs the most quickly of all.

 Αν το επίρρημα είναι ανώμαλο (fast, well, early, etc), τότε ο συγκριτικός και υπερθετικός βαθμός γίνονται σαν να ήταν επίθετα.

Tom runs **faster than** George. Tom runs **the fastest of all.**
