as+ επίθετο + as → he night is **as dark as** hell.

ή

not as/so + επίθετο + as → Our house is **not as luxurious as** a hotel.

A. MORE COMPARISONS

1. The night **is** **as** **dark** **as** hell.

noun or pronoun	positive verb	as	adjective	as	noun or pronoun
-----------------	---------------	----	-----------	----	-----------------

2. Our house **is not** **as/so** **luxurious** **as** a hotel.

noun or pronoun	negative verb	as / so	adjective	as	noun or pronoun
-----------------	---------------	---------	-----------	----	-----------------
