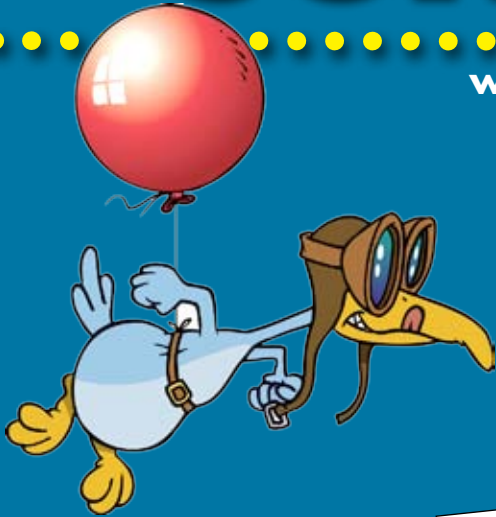

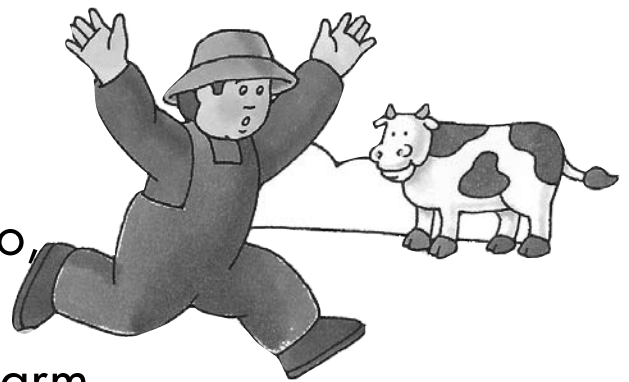
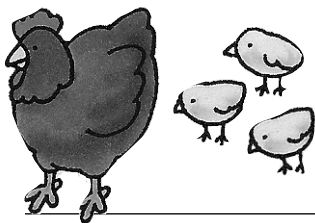
Circle Game:
