




# DIFFERENCES

- Movies are in electronic format
- **Books** can be both printed and in electronic format.
- Movies provide visual pleasure
- **Books** provide mental pleasure
- Movies present all the feelings of life in a standard way

- Movies become the collective output of many artists and technicians

# WHAT HAPPENS TO OUR BRAIN WHILE WE ARE READING A BOOK ?



- Diving into a great novel is an immersive experience that can make your brain come alive with imagery and emotions and even turn on your senses. Through reading, we can actually physically change our brain structure, become more empathetic, and even trick our brains into thinking we've experienced what we've only read in novels.

- Reading books and other materials with vivid imagery is not only fun, it also allows us to create worlds in our own minds. But did you know that this happens even if you don't mean it to? Researchers have found that visual imagery is simply automatic. Participants were able to identify photos of objects faster if they'd just read a sentence that described the object visually, suggesting that when we read a sentence, we automatically bring up pictures of objects in our minds.

- Also, when we read, we imagine many things we are not told, which creates our fantasy. Laurence Sterne, a writer, defined in a very interesting way the collaboration between the writer and the reader in the process of imagining what we read:

- “Writing is nothing more than a different name that is given to the conversation. And as no one who knows good company would dare to talk endlessly and say everything, neither will any author who understands well what the limits of decorum are and good manners he presumes to think. The largest and most sincere show of respect that can be given to the understanding of the reader is to share this task with him and let him imagine something in turn, almost, as the author himself”.


- The words of the books are like raindrops, chosen so that our mind is filled with thoughts and our heart with a bow ...
