## Toilets: WC

Americans weren't the first to use euphemisms to refer to the *toilet*. The toilet and/or the "outhouse" have at one time or another been called the "House of Honor" (by the ancient Israelites), the "House of the Morning" (by the ancient Egyptians), "Room 100" (in Europe) and many other terms.

There is no "real" word for the place where one deposits one's bodily wastes. "Toilet", which is now thought of as the "official" term, is itself a euphemism.
